





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 98.1% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit has declined from 99.6% in 2014-15 to 95.4% in 2018-19, while the percentage of non-credit sections has increased from 0.6% in 2014-15 to 4.4% in 2018-19.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the District increased by 21.1% from 4,570 in 2014-15 to 5,536 in 2018-19. An increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (+769 sections, a 18.2% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for non-credit, not degree applicable (-26 sections, a 7.8% decrease).

Although it presents a small percentage of total section offerings, non-credit section offerings dramatically increased (+233 sections, a 1238.9% increase).

Number of Sections by Credit Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 99.1% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit declined from 99.0% in 2014-15 to 98.4% in 2018-19, while the percentage of non-credit sections increased from 1.0% in 2014-15 to 1.6% in 2018-19.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by Crafton Hills College increased by 16.3%, from 1,548 in 2014-15 to 1,801 in 2018-19. An increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (+253 sections, a 17.7% increase) and for non-credit (+13 sections, a 81.3% increase). However, a decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, not degree applicable (-13 sections, a 12.7% decrease).

Number of Sections by Credit Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 97.6% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were for credit. The percentage of sections for credit declined from 99.9% in 2014-15 to 94.3% in 2018-19, while the percentage of non-credit sections increased by 5.6%, from 0.1% in 2014-15 to 5.7% in 2018-19

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the college increased by 23.6% from 3,022 in 2014-15 to 3,735 in 2018-19. An increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (+516 sections, a 18.5% increase) and for non-credit (+210 sections, a 10,500.0% increase). However, a decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, not degree applicable (-13 sections, a 5.7% decrease).

Number of Sections by Transfer Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 75.5% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable declined by 0.3%, from 74.8% in 2014-15 to 74.5% in 2018-19.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+516 sections, a 28.0% increase), transferable only to CSU (+190 sections, a 12.1% increase), and not transferable (+260 sections, a 22.6% increase).

Number of Sections by Transfer Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 80.1% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of total sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 2.9%, from 77.6% in 2014-15 to 80.5% in 2018-19.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+405 sections, a 53.6% increase) and not transferable (+4 sections, a 1.2% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among transferable only to CSU (-156 sections, a 35.0% decrease).

Number of Sections by Transfer Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 73.3% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable declined by 1.8%, from 73.4% in 2014-15 to 71.6% in 2018-19.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+111 sections, a 26.0% increase), transferable only to CSU (+346 sections, a 56.0% increase), and not transferable (+256 sections, a 32.1% increase).

Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 21.1% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 2.0%, from 21.0% in 2014-15 to 23.0% in 2018-19.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+ 311 sections, a 32.4% increase) and for Non-CTE courses (+655 sections, a 18.1% increase).

Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 13.2% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 1.8%, from 13.1% in 2014-15 to 14.9% in 2018-19.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+66 sections, a 32.5% increase) and for Non-CTE courses (+187 sections, a 13.9% increase).

Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 24.9% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 1.8%, from 25.0% in 2014-15 to 26.8% in 2018-19.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+245 sections, a 32.4% increase) and for Non-CTE courses (+468 sections, a 20.7% increase).

Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 7.1% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses stayed the same (7.1%).

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (+68 sections, a 21.0% increase) and for Non-Basic Skills (+898 sections, a 21.1% increase).

Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 5.9% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 2.5%, from 7.2% in 2014-15 to 4.7% in 2018-19.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills Courses (-28 sections, a 25.0% decrease), while an increase in the number of Non-Basic skills sections increased by 19.6% (+281 sections, a 19.6% increase).

Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 7.8% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses increased by 1.2%, from 7.0% in 2014-15 to 8.2% in 2018-19.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (+96 sections, a 45.3% increase) and for Non-Basic Skills courses (+617 sections, a 22.0% increase).

Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: SBCCD





Between 2014-15 and 2018-19, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) significantly declined by 15.5%, from 66.0% in 2014-15 to 50.5% in 2018-19. Over the same period, the percentage of Positive Attendance section offerings (+6.7%), Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+4.8%), and Daily Census section offerings (+4.0%) increased.

Over this period, there was an increase in Daily Census section offerings (+365 sections, a 53.2% increase), positive attendance section offerings (+422 sections, a 179.6% increase), and Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+399 sections, a 63.0% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-220 sections, a 7.3% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: Crafton Hills College





Between 2014-15 and 2018-19, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) significantly declined by 17.4%, from 68.9% in 2014-15 to 51.5% in 2018-19. Over the same period, the percentage of Daily Census section offerings (+7.5%), Independent Study, Work Experience section offerings (+6.6%), and Positive Attendance section offerings (+3.4%) increased.

Over this period, there was a larger increase in Daily Census section offerings (+173 sections, a 72.4% increase), Positive Attendance section offerings (+78 sections, a 78.0% increase), and Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+142 sections, a 100.0% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-140 sections, a 13.1% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: San Bernardino Valley College





Between 2014-15 and 2018-19, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) declined by 14.5%, from 64.5% in 2014-15 to 50.0% in 2018-19. Over the same period, the percentage of Positive Attendance offerings (8.4%), Independent study and work experience section offerings (+3.8%), and Daily census section offerings (+2.3%) increased.

Over the period, there was an increase in Daily Census section offerings (+192 sections, a 43.0% increase), Positive Attendance section offerings (+344 sections, a 254.8% increase), and Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+257 sections, a 52.3% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-80 sections, a 4.1% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Location



Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: SBCCD





Between 2014-15 and 2018-19, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings has declined by 6.1%, from 86.1% in 2014-15 to 80.0% in 2018-19. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 5.4%, from 9.6% in 2014-15 to 15.0% in 2018-19.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among face to face section offerings (+493 sections, a 12.5% increase), fully online section offerings (+391 sections, a 88.9% increase), and hybrid section offerings (+87 sections, a 45.9% increase). A decrease in the number of sections was observed among Remote section offerings (-2 sections, a 20.0% decrease.)

Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: Crafton Hills College





Between 2014-15 and 2018-19, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings has declined by 7.5%, from 92.2% in 2014-15 to 84.7% in 2018-19. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 6.5%, from 6.8% in 2014-15 to 13.3% in 2018-19.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among face to face section offerings (+97 sections, a 6.8% increase), fully online section offerings (+133 sections, a 125.5% increase), and hybrid section offerings (+23 sections, a 164.3% increase).

Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: San Bernardino Valley College





Between 2014-15 and 2018-19, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings has declined by 5.2% from 83.0% in 2014-15 to 77.8% in 2018-19. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 4.8%, from 11.1% in 2014-15 to 15.9% in 2018-19.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among face to face section offerings (+396 sections, a 15.8% increase), fully online section offerings (+258 sections, a 77.2% increase), and hybrid section offerings (+61 sections, a 36.1% increase). A decrease in the number of sections was observed among Remote section offerings (-2 sections, a 20.0% decrease.)


On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 61.1% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Evening and Day has declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 7.0%, from 13.6% in 2014-15 to 20.6% in 2018-19.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Day section offerings (+457 sections, a 16.0% increase), and Unknown section offerings (+520 sections, a 83.5% increase). However, a decrease was observed among evening section offerings (-11 sections, a 1.0% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Meeting Time: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 63.9% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Evening and Day has declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 7.8%, from 12.0% in 2014-15 to 19.8% in 2018-19.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Day section offerings (+88 sections, a 8.6% increase and Unknown section offerings (+170 sections, a 91.4% increase). However, a decrease was observed among evening section offerings (-5 sections, a 1.5% decrease).

On average, between 2014-15 and 2018-19, 59.7% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Evening and Day has declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 6.6%, from 14.5% in 2014-15 to 21.1% in 2018-19.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among Day section offerings (+369 section, a 20.0% increase) and Unknown section offerings (+350 sections, a 80.1% increase). However, a decrease was observed among Evening section offerings (-6 sections, a 0.8% decrease).
