Educational Master Planning Project

December 16, 2022 – Final Project Update

The Educational Master Planning (EMP) Project for SBCCD and its two colleges, Crafton Hills College (CHC) and San Bernardino Valley College (SBVC), has now completed its work. Each college's Educational Master Plan Committee (EMPC), with technical / facilitative support by the *Collaborative Brain Trust (CBT)*, met regularly throughout the Fall Semester to complete project activities and provide oversight to plan development. Christopher Crew, Interim Director of Research, Planning, and Institutional Effectiveness, and Nohemy Ornelas, Vice Chancellor of Educational and Student Support Services, served as the District liaisons to CBT for the project.

The two college Educational Master Plan Committees (EMPCs) and the CBT team progressed through the three-phase project, working with the EMPC liaisons, Gio Sosa (CHC) and Joanna Oxendine (SBVC). Following the October goal-setting sessions, each college's EMPC reviewed and refined the *Strategic Directions and Supporting Actions*, in alignment with the *SBCCD Strategic Plan 2022-2027*, that were developed at their respective sessions. A multi-week campus review followed, and the EMPCs met again in early December to review feedback and consider any further revisions.

The final draft of each college's *Educational Master Plan 2023 -2028* is now complete, and the project was completed December 16, 2022. The Draft EMPs are scheduled to go to the Board of Trustees in Spring, following final participatory governance reviews.

The CBT team congratulates both colleges on a job well done, with a special appreciation to the EMP Committees for not only their time commitment and hard work, but also their thoughtful efforts to be inclusive and to provide direction for San Bernardino Valley College and Crafton Hills College for their next five years in serving students, communities, and employers of the region.
