Take Control of Your Inventory!

Inventory control or stock control can be broadly defined as, “the activity of checking a shop’s stock.” However, a more focused definition takes into account the more science-based, methodical practice of not only verifying a business' inventory, but also focusing on the many related facets of inventory management (such as forecasting future demand), “within an organization to meet the demand placed upon that business economically.” Other aspects of inventory control include supply chain management, production control, financial flexibility, and customer satisfaction. The foundations of inventory control encompass whether or not inventory control is a problem and determining when to order more. While understanding ‘the where’ which stems in the logistics of those decisions.

In general, inventory represents a key component of business productivity, profitability, and success. In the Manufacture Industry, it represents raw materials and/or finished goods. Raw materials, and sometimes finished goods, enable the final finished product to be made on time. In Logistics, it is a product that is being selected and sent to a prospective customer. Products received, shelved, and selected upon demand to ship out to a distribution outlet, manufacture facility, or a simple end user. In Retail, inventory represents the product on the shelves--for customers to see and purchase!

After this training, employees will understand these components and cycles to improve the management of inventory control at your company.
