## Featured Membership Benefit

Educators Employment Liability (EEL) Insurance provides CTA members with up to \$1,000,000 in liability protection and up to \$3,000,000 in legal costs for defending against civil claims or lawsuits related to their educational employment. The coverage also includes reimbursement for attorneys' fees in certain aread. # Negotiations Update

A wages proposal was shared by SBCCDTA with the district. Full-time faculty are anywhere from 10.75% - 25.16% below the median and part-time faculty are behind the median by 11.10% for instructional faculty and 5.42% for non-instructional faculty. We have proposed a multi-year plan to bring all faculty to median as well as address the disparity below the median for different steps. Key components of the plan include the following:

- Percentage increases every year.
- Addressing the disparity between steps
- Adding steps for part-time faculty.
- Adding prep and grading pay for part-time instructional faculty.
- Getting to median!
- After getting to median, regular ongoing increases (like COLA) to ensure we do not fall far below.

We are currently awaiting the district's counter proposal.

### High Intensity Lab

The "High Intensity Lab" workgroup met January 14th to go over applications and make final recommendations to the campus presidents. There were 102 applications and the committee recommended to approve all of them. The presidents will make a final decision by January 24, 2025!
