



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Employees by Job Classification Group, Fall 2023





Employee Racial/Ethnic Distribution, Fall 2023



Racial/Ethnic Frequency Distribution, Fall 2023



Gender Distribution, Fall 2023



Gender Distribution By Employee Classification, Fall 2023



In Fall 2023, there was a higher number of males than females in classified administrator positions, while there was a higher number of females than males in tenured/tenure track faculty, academic temporary, and classified staff positions. Classified staff had the largest gender gap (30.8% - 65.4% female vs. 34.6% male), followed by tenured/tenure track faculty (11.6% - 55.8% female vs. 44.2% male), classified administrator (10.6% - 44.7% female vs. 55.3% male), and academic temporary (3.4% - 51.7% female vs. 48.3% male).

Age Distribution, Fall 2023



In Fall 2023, the three largest age groups among SBCCD employees were employees 40-49 years of age (28.0%), employees 50-59 years of age (24.1%), and employees 30-39 years of age (22.2%). Together these age groups made up nearly 74.3% of employees at SBCCD.

In Fall 2023, the median age of educational administrator is the highest at 53.9 years. Tenured/Tenure track faculty median age of 50.9 years is the next highest. Classified Staff had the lowest median age (45.1 years).
