



On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 97.9% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit has declined from 99.1% in 2016-17 to 98.3% in 2020-21, while the percentage of non-credit sections has increased from 0.9% in 2016-17 to 1.7% in 2020-21.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the District declined by 1.1% from 4,964 in 2016-17 to 4,909 in 2020-21. An increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (+150 sections, a 3.3% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, not degree applicable (-243 sections, a 68.3% decrease).

Although it represents a small percentage of total section offerings, non-credit section offerings increased (+38 sections, a 84.4% increase).

#### Number of Sections by Credit Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 99.4% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit slightly increased from 99.2% in 2016-17 to 99.9% in 2020-21, while the percentage of non-credit sections slightly declined from 0.8% in 2016-17 to 0.1% in 2020-21.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by Crafton Hills College declined by 7.4%, from 1,659 in 2016-17 to 1,537 in 2020-21. A decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (-41 sections, a 2.7% decrease), for credit, not degree applicable (-69 sections, a 62.2% decrease), and for non-credit (-12 sections, a 85.7% decrease).

#### Number of Sections by Credit Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 97.2% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were for credit. The percentage of sections for credit declined from 99.1% in 2016-17 to 97.6% in 2020-21, while the percentage of non-credit sections increased from 0.9% in 2016-17 to 2.4% in 2020-21.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the college increased by 2.0% from 3,305 in 2016-17 to 3,372 in 2020-21. An increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (+191 sections, a 6.3% increase) and for non-credit (+50 sections, a 161.3% increase). However, a decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, not degree applicable (-174 sections, a 71.0% decrease).



On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 78.5% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 7.1%, from 76.6% in 2016-17 to 83.7% in 2020-21.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+1,327 sections, a 66.0% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable only to CSU (-1,022 sections, a 57.0% decrease) and not transferable (-360 sections, a 31.0% decrease).



On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 83.4% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of total sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 6.5%, from 80.4% in 2016-17 to 86.9% in 2020-21.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+196 sections, a 23.3% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable only to CSU (-194 sections, a 39.5% decrease) and not transferable (-124 sections, a 38.2% decrease).

#### Number of Sections by Transfer Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 76.1% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 6.8%, from 74.7% in 2016-17 to 81.5% in 2020-21.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+1,131 sections, a 96.8%) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among transferable only to CSU (-828 sections, a 63.6% decrease) and not transferable (-236 sections, a 28.3% decrease).

# Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 20.9% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 4.1%, from 18.7% in 2016-17 to 22.8% in 2020-21.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+191 sections, a 20.6% increase), while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-CTE courses (-246 sections, a 6.1% decrease).



On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 13.8% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 5.0%, from 11.9% in 2016-17 to 16.9% in 2020-21.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+62 sections, a 31.3% increase), while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-CTE courses (-184 sections, a 12.6% decrease).



On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 24.2% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 3.4%, from 22.0% in 2016-17 to 25.4% in 2020-21.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+129 sections, a 17.7% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-CTE courses (-62 sections, a 2.4% decrease).

#### Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 4.9% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 5.3% from 7.3% in 2016-17 to 2.0% in 2020-21.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-Basic Skills (+208 sections, a 4.5% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (-263 sections, a 72.7% decrease).



On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 4.2% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 4.8%, from 6.7% in 2016-17 to 1.9% in 2020-21.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (-82 sections, a 73.9% decrease) and for Non-Basic Skills (-40 sections, a 2.6% decrease).

#### Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 5.3% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 5.5%, from 7.6% in 2016-17 to 2.1% in 2020-21.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among for Non-Basic Skills (+248 sections, a 8.1% increase), while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (-181 sections, a 72.1% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: SBCCD





Between 2016-17 and 2020-21, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-37.5%) and Daily Census section offerings (-6.8%) declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+42.7%) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+1.7%) increased.

Over this period, there was an increase in positive attendance section offerings (+80 sections, a 40.0% increase) and Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+2,085 sections, a 243.9% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-1,876 sections, a 62.9% decrease) and Daily Census section offerings (-344 sections, a 37.1% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: Crafton Hills College





Between 2016-17 and 2020-21, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-27.1%), Daily Census section offerings (-4.1%), and Positive Attendance section offerings (-0.5%) declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+31.6%) increased.

Over this period, there was a larger increase in Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+469 sections, a 210.3% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-489 sections, a 49.2% decrease), Daily Census section offerings (-89 sections, a 24.7% decrease), and Positive Attendance section offerings (-13 sections, a 15.9% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: San Bernardino Valley College





Between 2016-17 and 2020-21, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-42.3%) and Daily census section offerings (-7.9%) declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Independent study and work experience section offerings (+47.5%) and Positive Attendance offerings (2.7%) increased.

Over the period, there was an increase in Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+1,616 sections, a 255.7% increase) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+93 sections, a 78.8% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-1,387 sections, a 69.8% decrease) and Daily Census section offerings (-255 sections, a 45.0% decrease).



#### Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: SBCCD





Between 2016-17 and 2020-21, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 66.1%, from 81.5% in 2016-17 to 15.4% in 2020-21. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 66.6%, from 12.8% in 2016-17 to 79.4% in 2020-21.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+3,264 sections, a 513.2% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-3,292 sections, 81.3% decrease) and hybrid section offerings (-22 sections, a 8.0% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: Crafton Hills College





Between 2016-17 and 2020-21, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 45.7%, from 87.3% in 2016-17 to 41.6% in 2020-21. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 44.3%, from 10.8% in 2016-17 to 55.0% in 2020-21.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+669 sections, a 372.6% increase) and hybrid section offerings (+20 sections, a 64.5% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-809 sections, 55.8% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: San Bernardino Valley College





Between 2016-17 and 2020-21, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 75.2%, from 78.6% in 2016-17 to 3.4% in 2020-21. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 76.7%, from 13.8% in 2016-17 to 90.6% in 2020-21.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+2,597 sections, a 568.3% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-2,483 sections, 95.6% decrease) and hybrid section offerings (-42 sections, a 17.1% decrease).


On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 53.4% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day declined by 40.4% from 61.2% in 2016-17 to 20.8% in 2020-21. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 56.7%, from 16.6% in 2016-17 to 73.3% in 2020-21.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+2,772 sections, a 336.0% increase). However, a decrease was observed among evening section offerings (-809 sections, a 73.5% decrease) and Day section offerings (-2,018 sections, a 66.4% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Meeting Time: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 61.8% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day has declined by 10.8% from 63.7% in 2016-17 to 53.0% in 2020-21. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 16.8%, from 16.3% in 2016-17 to 33.1% in 2020-21.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+238 sections, a 88.1% increase). However, a decrease was observed among evening section offerings (-117 sections, a 35.2% decrease) and Day section offerings (-243 sections, a 23.0% decrease).

On average, between 2016-17 and 2020-21, 49.4% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day declined by 53.9% from 60.0% in 2016-17 to 6.1% in 2020-21. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 74.8%, from 16.8% in 2016-17 to 91.6% in 2020-21.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+2,534 sections, a 456.6% increase). However, a decrease was observed among Evening section offerings (-692 sections, a 90.1% decrease) and Day section offerings (-1,775 sections, a 89.6% decrease).
