



On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 97.6% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit has declined from 97.7% in 2017-18 to 97.2% in 2021-22, while the percentage of non-credit sections has increased from 0.5% in 2017-18 to 2.8% in 2021-22.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the District declined by 8.3% from 5,249 in 2017-18 to 4,813 in 2021-22. A decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (-266 sections, a 5.6% decrease), and for credit, not degree applicable (-184 sections, a 53.3% decrease), while an increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for non-credit (+14 sections, a 11.7% increase).

Number of Sections by Credit Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 99.4% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit slightly declined from 99.5% in 2017-18 to 99.1% in 2021-22, while the percentage of non-credit sections slightly increased from 0.5% in 2017-18 to 0.9% in 2021-22.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by Crafton Hills College declined by 7.4%, from 1,648 in 2017-18 to 1,526 in 2021-22. A decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (-80 sections, a 5.2% decrease) and for credit, not degree applicable (-48 sections, a 51.2% decrease). However, an increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for non-credit (+6 sections, a 75.0% increase).

Number of Sections by Credit Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 95.9% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were for credit. The percentage of sections for credit slightly declined from 96.9% in 2017-18 to 96.5% in 2021-22, while the percentage of non-credit sections slightly increased from 3.1% in 2017-18 to 3.5% in 2021-22.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the college declined by 4.3% from 3,601 in 2017-18 to 3,447 in 2021-22. A decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (-186 sections, a 5.7% decrease) and for credit, not degree applicable (-136 sections, a 54.2% decrease). However, an increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for non-credit (+8 sections, a 7.1% increase).

Number of Sections by Transfer Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 79.7% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 7.1%, from 75.8% in 2017-18 to 82.9% in 2021-22.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+878 sections, a 38.7% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable only to CSU (-866 sections, a 50.5% decrease) and not transferable (-448 sections, a 35.3% decrease).

Number of Sections by Transfer Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 85.2% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of total sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 7.9%, from 81.6% in 2017-18 to 89.5% in 2021-22.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable only to CSU (+78 sections, a 27.3% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (-57 sections, a 5.4% decrease) and not transferable (-143 sections, a 47.2% decrease).

Number of Sections by Transfer Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 77.1% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 6.7%, from 73.2% in 2017-18 to 79.9% in 2021-22.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+935 sections, a 77.5%) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among transferable only to CSU (-944 sections, a 66.1% decrease) and not transferable (-305 sections, a 31.6% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 22.1% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 4.0%, from 20.8% in 2017-18 to 24.8% in 2021-22.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+100 sections, a 9.1% increase), while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-CTE courses (-536 sections, a 12.9% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 15.0% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 5.2%, from 12.7% in 2017-18 to 17.9% in 2021-22.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+63 sections, a 30.0% increase), while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-CTE courses (-185 sections, a 12.9% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 25.4% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 3.5%, from 24.5% in 2017-18 to 28.0% in 2021-22.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+37 sections, a 4.2% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-CTE courses (-351 sections, a 12.9% decrease).

Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 4.1% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 4.4% from 7.2% in 2017-18 to 2.8% in 2021-22.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (-246 sections, a 64.9% decrease) and for Non-Basic Skills (-190 sections, a 3.9% decrease).

Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 3.3% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 3.5%, from 5.3% in 2017-18 to 1.8% in 2021-22.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (-61 sections, a 69.3% decrease) and for Non-Basic Skills (-61 sections, a 3.9% decrease).

Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 4.5% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 4.5%, from 8.1% in 2017-18 to 3.2% in 2021-22.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (-185 sections, a 63.6% decrease) and for Non-Basic Skills (-129 sections, a 3.9% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: SBCCD





Between 2017-18 and 2021-22, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-30.2%) and Daily Census section offerings (-4.6%) declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+34.8%) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+0.1%) increased.

Over this period, there was an increase in Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+1,597 sections, a 169.4% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-1,696 sections, a 58.7% decrease), Daily Census section offerings (-308 sections, a 29.9% decrease), and Positive Attendance section offerings (-29 sections, a 7.5% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: Crafton Hills College





Between 2017-18 and 2021-22, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-28.1%) and Daily Census section offerings (-6.8%). Over the same period, the percentage of Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+34.0%) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+0.9%) increased.

Over this period, there was a larger increase in Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+502 sections, a 221.1% increase) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+7 sections, a 7.1 % increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-497 sections, a 54.3% decrease) and Daily Census section offerings (-134 sections, a 33.0% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: San Bernardino Valley College





Between 2017-18 and 2021-22, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-31.2%), Daily census section offerings (-3.6%), and Positive Attendance offerings (-0.3%) declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Independent study and work experience section offerings (+35.2%) increased.

Over the period, there was an increase in Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+1,095 sections, a 152.9% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-1,199 sections, a 60.7% decrease), Daily Census section offerings (-174 sections, a 27.9% decrease), and Positive Attendance section offerings (-36 sections, a 12.6% decrease).



Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections offered at CHC Off-Campus (+37 sections, a 59.7% increase). However, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections offered at SBVC Big Bear High School (-21 sections, a 95.5% decrease), SBVC Off-Campus (-60 sections, a 88.2% decrease), and SB Sheriff Dept. Training Center (-7 sections, a 25.9% decrease).

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Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: SBCCD





Between 2017-18 and 2021-22, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 53.7%, from 80.8% in 2017-18 to 27.1% in 2021-22. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 47.7%, from 13.8% in 2017-18 to 61.5% in 2021-22.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+2,237 sections, a 309.4% increase) and hybrid section offerings (+272 sections, a 97.8% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-2,937 sections, a 69.3 % decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: Crafton Hills College





Between 2017-18 and 2021-22, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 52.8%, from 87.0% in 2017-18 to 34.2% in 2021-22. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 49.6%, from 11.5% in 2017-18 to 61.1% in 2021-22.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+743 sections, a 393.1% increase) and hybrid section offerings (+47 sections, a 188.0% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-912 sections, a 63.6% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: San Bernardino Valley College





Between 2017-18 and 2021-22, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 54.2%, from 77.9% in 2017-18 to 23.8% in 2021-22. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 46.9%, from 14.8% in 2017-18 to 61.7% in 2021-22.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+1,494 sections, a 279.8% increase) and hybrid section offerings (+225 sections, a 88.9% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-2,025 sections, a 72.2% decrease).


On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 49.0% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day declined by 22.8% from 61.1% in 2017-18 to 38.3% in 2021-22. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 34.0%, from 18.0% in 2017-18 to 52.0% in 2021-22.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+1,557 sections, a 164.9% increase). However, a decrease was observed among evening section offerings (-628 sections, a 57.2% decrease) and Day section offerings (-1,365 sections, a 42.5% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Meeting Time: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 58.6% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day has declined by 17.7% from 64.6% in 2017-18 to 46.9% in 2021-22. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 26.3%, from 16.4% in 2017-18 to 42.7% in 2021-22.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+382 sections, a 141.5% increase). However, a decrease was observed among evening section offerings (-155 sections, a 49.5% decrease) and Day section offerings (-349 sections, a 32.8% decrease).

On average, between 2017-18 and 2021-22, 44.5% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day declined by 25.2% from 59.5% in 2017-18 to 34.3% in 2021-22. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 37.6%, from 18.7% in 2017-18 to 56.3% in 2021-22.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+1,175 sections, a 174.3% increase). However, a decrease was observed among Evening section offerings (-473 sections, a 60.3% decrease) and Day section offerings (-1,016 sections, a 47.4% decrease).
