



On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 97.2% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit has declined from 96.8% in 2018-19 to 95.7% in 2022-23, while the percentage of non-credit sections has increased from 3.2% in 2018-19 to 4.3% in 2022-23.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the District declined by 9.6% from 5,353 in 2018-19 to 4,840 in 2022-23. A decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (-307 sections, a 6.3% decrease), and for credit, not degree applicable (-241 sections, a 79.8% decrease), while an increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for non-credit (+35 sections, a 20.5% increase).

#### Number of Sections by Credit Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 99.1% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit slightly declined from 98.9% in 2018-19 to 98.1% in 2022-23, while the percentage of non-credit sections slightly increased from 1.1% in 2018-19 to 1.9% in 2022-23.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by Crafton Hills College declined by 10.2%, from 1,724 in 2018-19 to 1,549 in 2022-23. A decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (-146 sections, a 9.0% decrease) and for credit, not degree applicable (-40 sections, a 47.1% decrease). However, an increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for non-credit (+11 sections, a 57.9% increase).

#### Number of Sections by Credit Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 95.4% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were for credit. The percentage of sections for credit slightly declined from 95.8% in 2018-19 to 94.7% in 2022-23, while the percentage of non-credit sections slightly increased from 4.2% in 2018-19 to 5.3% in 2022-23.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the college declined by 9.3% from 3,629 in 2018-19 to 3,291 in 2022-23. A decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (-161 sections, a 4.9% decrease) and for credit, not degree applicable (-201 sections, a 92.6% decrease). However, an increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for non-credit (+24 sections, a 15.8% increase).



On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 81.0% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 6.9%, from 75.4% in 2018-19 to 82.3% in 2022-23.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+864 sections, a 37.1% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable only to CSU (-915 sections, a 53.7% decrease) and not transferable (-462 sections, a 35.1% decrease).



On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 86.6% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of total sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 7.2%, from 81.3% in 2018-19 to 88.5% in 2022-23.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable only to CSU (+79 sections, a 29.3% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (-109 sections, a 9.6% decrease) and not transferable (-145 sections, a 44.9% decrease).

#### Number of Sections by Transfer Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 78.4% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 6.8%, from 72.6% in 2018-19 to 79.4% in 2022-23.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+973 sections, a 81.2%) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among transferable only to CSU (-994 sections, a 69.3% decrease) and not transferable (-317 sections, a 31.9% decrease).

## Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 22.8% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 2.4%, from 22.2% in 2018-19 to 24.6% in 2022-23.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+6 sections, a 0.5% increase), while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-CTE courses (-519 sections, a 12.5% decrease).



On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 16.3% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 5.4%, from 14.2% in 2018-19 to 19.6% in 2022-23.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+58 sections, a 23.7% increase), while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-CTE courses (-233 sections, a 15.8% decrease).



On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 25.9% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 1.1%, from 25.9% in 2018-19 to 27.0% in 2022-23.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-CTE courses (-286 sections, a 10.6% decrease) and for CTE courses (-52 sections, a 5.5% decrease).

## Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 3.4% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 2.5% from 6.3% in 2018-19 to 3.8% in 2022-23.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (-154 sections, a 45.9% decrease) and for Non-Basic Skills (-359 sections, a 7.2% decrease).



On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 2.6% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 2.1%, from 4.3% in 2018-19 to 2.2% in 2022-23.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (-40 sections, a 54.1% decrease) and for Non-Basic Skills (-135 sections, a 8.2% decrease).

#### Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 3.7% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 2.7%, from 7.3% in 2018-19 to 4.6% in 2022-23.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (-114 sections, a 43.2% decrease) and for Non-Basic Skills (-224 sections, a 6.7% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: SBCCD





Between 2018-19 and 2022-23, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-24.2%) and Daily Census section offerings (-1.3%) declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+25.3%) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+0.3%) increased.

Over this period, there was an increase in Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+1,127 sections, a 109.0% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-1,442 sections, a 51.6% decrease), Daily Census section offerings (-166 sections, a 15.8% decrease), and Positive Attendance section offerings (-32 sections, a 6.8% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: Crafton Hills College





Between 2018-19 and 2022-23, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-25.2%) and Daily Census section offerings (-1.1%). Over the same period, the percentage of Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+22.7%) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+3.6%) increased.

Over this period, there was a larger increase in Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+323 sections, a 113.3% increase) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+46 sections, a 46.0 % increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-485 sections, a 52.3% decrease) and Daily Census section offerings (-59 sections, a 14.3% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: San Bernardino Valley College





Between 2018-19 and 2022-23, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-23.8%), Daily census section offerings (-1.4%), and Positive Attendance offerings (-1.3%) declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Independent study and work experience section offerings (+26.6%) increased.

Over the period, there was an increase in Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+804 sections, a 107.3% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-957 sections, a 51.2% decrease), Daily Census section offerings (-107 sections, a 16.7% decrease), and Positive Attendance section offerings (-78 sections, a 21.0% decrease).

## **Number of Sections Offered by Location**





The percentage of sections offered at the SBVC and CHC Campuses increased by 1.4% from 95.6% in 2018-19 to 97.2% in 2022-23.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections offered at CHC Off-Campus (+40 sections, a 56.3% increase). However, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections offered at SBVC Big Bear High School (-19 sections, a 100% decrease), SBVC Off-Campus (-97 sections, a 82.2% decrease), SB Sheriff Dept. Training Center (-21 sections, a 80.8% decrease), CHC Campus (-215 sections, a 13.0% decrease), and SBVC Campus (-201 sections, a 5.8% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: SBCCD





Between 2018-19 and 2022-23, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 36.4%, from 79.3% in 2018-19 to 42.9% in 2022-23. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 32.2%, from 15.5% in 2018-19 to 47.7% in 2022-23.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+1,476 sections, a 177.4% increase) and hybrid section offerings (+190 sections, a 71.2% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-2,171 sections, a 51.1 % decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: Crafton Hills College





Between 2018-19 and 2022-23, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 32.5%, from 84.0% in 2018-19 to 51.5% in 2022-23. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 30.1%, from 13.9% in 2018-19 to 44.0% in 2022-23.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+442 sections, a 184.9% increase) and hybrid section offerings (+34 sections, a 91.9% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-651 sections, a 45.0% decrease).

#### Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: San Bernardino Valley College





Between 2018-19 and 2022-23, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 38.3%, from 77.1% in 2018-19 to 38.8% in 2022-23. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 33.1%, from 16.3% in 2018-19 to 49.4% in 2022-23.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+1,034 sections, a 174.4% increase) and hybrid section offerings (+156 sections, a 67.8% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-1,520 sections, a 54.3% decrease).


On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 45.3% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day declined by 17.9% from 61.0% in 2018-19 to 43.1% in 2022-23. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 26.7%, from 19.4% in 2018-19 to 46.1% in 2022-23.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+1,197 sections, a 115.5% increase). However, a decrease was observed among evening section offerings (-531 sections, a 50.4% decrease) and Day section offerings (-1,179 sections, a 36.1% decrease).



On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 55.5% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day has declined by 14.1% from 62.8% in 2018-19 to 48.7% in 2022-23. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 23.5%, from 18.3% in 2018-19 to 41.8% in 2022-23.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+331 sections, a 104.7% increase). However, a decrease was observed among evening section offerings (-179 sections, a 54.9% decrease) and Day section offerings (-327 sections, a 30.2% decrease).

On average, between 2018-19 and 2022-23, 40.6% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day declined by 19.7% from 60.1% in 2018-19 to 40.4% in 2022-23. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 28.4%, from 19.8% in 2018-19 to 48.2% in 2022-23.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+866 sections, a 120.3% increase). However, a decrease was observed among Evening section offerings (-352 sections, a 48.4% decrease) and Day section offerings (-852 sections, a 39.0% decrease).
