



On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 96.7% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit has declined from 97.9% in 2019-20 to 94.7% in 2023-24, while the percentage of non-credit sections has increased from 2.1% in 2019-20 to 5.3% in 2023-24.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the District increased by 3.0% from 5,295 in 2019-20 to 5,454 in 2023-24. A decrease in the number of sections was observed in and for credit, not degree applicable (-26 sections, a 32.1% decrease), while an increase in the number of sections was observed in sections sections for credit, degree applicable (+6 sections, a 0.1% increase) and for non-credit (+179 sections, a 161.3% increase).

Number of Sections by Credit Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 98.9% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were for credit. The percentage of all sections for credit declined from 99.8% in 2019-20 to 97.7% in 2023-24, while the percentage of non-credit sections increased from 0.2% in 2019-20 to 2.3% in 2023-24.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by Crafton Hills College declined by 4.3%, from 1,702 in 2019-20 to 1,628 in 2023-24. A decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (-86 sections, a 5.2% decrease) and for credit, not degree applicable (-21 sections, a 36.8% decrease). However, an increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for non-credit (+33 sections, a 825.0% increase).

Number of Sections by Credit Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 94.9% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were for credit. The percentage of sections for credit declined from 97.0% in 2019-20 to 93.4% in 2023-24, while the percentage of non-credit sections increased from 3.0% in 2019-20 to 6.6% in 2023-24.

Over this period, the number of sections offered by the college increased by 6.5% from 3,593 in 2019-20 to 3,826 in 2023-24. A decrease in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, not degree applicable (-5 sections, a 20.8% decrease). However, an increase in the number of sections was observed in sections for credit, degree applicable (+92 sections, a 2.7% increase) and for non-credit (+146 sections, a 136.4% increase).

Number of Sections by Transfer Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 82.5% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 1.4%, from 81.1% in 2019-20 to 82.5% in 2023-24.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+200 sections, a 5.8% increase) and transferable only to CSU (+7 sections, a 0.8% decrease) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections not transferable (-48 sections, a 4.8% decrease).

Number of Sections by Transfer Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 88.4% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of total sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 2.3%, from 87.3% in 2019-20 to 89.6% in 2023-24.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable only to CSU (+65 sections, a 21.6% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (-91 sections, a 7.7% decrease) and not transferable (-48 sections, a 22.1% decrease).

Number of Sections by Transfer Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 79.8% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable. The percentage of sections that were UC/CSU transferable or CSU-only transferable increased by 1.3%, from 78.2% in 2019-20 to 79.5% in 2023-24.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections transferable to both UC and CSU (+291 sections, a 12.8%) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among transferable only to CSU (-58 sections, a 10.8% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 23.0% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 3.2%, from 20.1% in 2019-20 to 23.3% in 2023-24.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+208 sections, a 19.6% increase), while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-CTE courses (-585 sections, a 13.8% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 17.3% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 5.4%, from 13.5% in 2019-20 to 18.9% in 2023-24.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+78 sections, a 33.9% increase), while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-CTE courses (-152 sections, a 10.3% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Career Technical Skills Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 25.7% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College were Career Technical Education (CTE). The percentage of CTE sections increased by 2.0%, from 23.2% in 2019-20 to 25.1% in 2023-24.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for CTE courses (+130 sections, a 15.6% increase) and for Non-CTE courses (+103 sections, a 3.7% increase).

Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: SBCCD





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 3.1% of sections offered by the San Bernardino Community College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses increased by 2.9% from 1.8% in 2019-20 to 4.7% in 2023-24.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (+162 sections, a 167.0% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Non-Basic Skills (-3 sections, a 0.1% decrease).

Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 2.1% of sections offered by Crafton Hills College were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses declined by 1.0%, from 2.8% in 2019-20 to 1.8% in 2023-24.

Over the period, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (-17 sections, a 36.2% decrease) and for Non-Basic Skills (-57 sections, a 3.4% decrease).

Number of Sections by Basic Skills Status: San Bernardino Valley College





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 3.5% of sections offered by San Bernardino Valley College District were in Basic Skills Courses. The percentage of total sections offered that were in Basic Skills Courses increased by 4.6%, from 1.4% in 2019-20 to 6.0% in 2023-24.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections for Basic Skills courses (+179 sections, a 358.0% increase) and for Non-Basic Skills (+54 sections, a 6.5% increase).

Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: SBCCD





Between 2019-20 and 2023-24, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-22.5%) and Daily Census section offerings (-1.0%) declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+18.7%) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+4.7%) increased.

Over this period, there was an increase in Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+1,057 sections, a 90.4% increase) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+266 sections, a 112.2% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-1,140 sections, a 40.5% decrease) and Daily Census section offerings (-24 sections, a 2.2% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: Crafton Hills College





Between 2019-20 and 2023-24, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-18.0%) and Daily Census section offerings (-5.2%). Over the same period, the percentage of Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+18.5%) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+4.6%) increased.

Over this period, there was an increase in Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+288 sections, a 87.8% increase) and Positive Attendance section offerings (+72 sections, a 116.1% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-329 sections, a 39.7% decrease) and Daily Census section offerings (-105 sections, a 21.7% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Attendance Accounting Method: San Bernardino Valley College





Between 2019-20 and 2023-24, the percentage of Weekly Census procedure section offerings (WSCH) (-24.6%) declined. Over the same period, the percentage of Independent study and work experience section offerings (+18.7%), Positive Attendance offerings (+4.8%), and Daily census section offerings (+1.1%) increased.

Over the period, there was an increase in Independent Study and Work Experience section offerings (+769 sections, a 91.4% increase), Positive Attendance section offerings (+194 sections, a 110.9% increase), and Daily Census section offerings (+81 sections, a 13.7% increase). However, a decrease was observed in Weekly Census section offerings (-811 sections, a 40.8% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Location





The percentage of sections offered at the SBVC and CHC Campuses increased by 0.9% from 95.7% in 2019-20 to 96.6% in 2023-24.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among sections offered at CHC Off-Campus (+45 sections, a 67.2% increase) and SBVC Campus (+322 sections, a 9.4% increase). However, a decrease in the number of sections was observed among sections offered at CHC Campus (-119 sections, a 7.3% decrease), SBVC Off-Campus (-77 sections, a 0.9% decrease), SBVC Big Bear High School (-11 sections, a 100% decrease), and SB Sheriff Dept. Training Center (-1 section, a 4.8% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: SBCCD





Between 2019-20 and 2023-24, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 30.2%, from 77.0% in 2019-20 to 46.8% in 2023-24. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 24.4%, from 18.6% in 2019-20 to 43.0% in 2023-24.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+1,359 sections, a +137.7% increase) and hybrid section offerings (+322 sections, a 139.4% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-1,522 sections, a 37.3 % decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Distance Learning Status: Crafton Hills College






Between 2019-20 and 2023-24, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 22.6%, from 80.3% in 2019-20 to 57.7% in 2023-24. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 21.4%, from 17.3% in 2019-20 to 38.7% in 2023-24.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+335 sections, a 113.6% increase) and hybrid section offerings (+18 sections, a 45.0% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-427 sections, a 31.2% decrease).







Between 2019-20 and 2023-24, the percentage of face-to-face section offerings declined by 33.2%, from 75.4% in 2019-20 to 42.2% in 2023-24. Over the same period, the percentage of fully online section offerings has increased by 25.6%, from 19.3% in 2019-20 to 44.9% in 2023-24.

Over this period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among fully online section offerings (+1,024 sections, a 148.0% increase) and hybrid section offerings (+304 sections, a 159.2% increase) while a decrease in the number of sections was observed among face face-to-face section offerings (-1,095 sections, a 40.4% decrease).


On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 41.7% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day declined by 16.8% from 60.8% in 2019-20 to 44.0% in 2023-24. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 23.7%, from 20.8% in 2019-20 to 44.5% in 2023-24.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+1,327 sections, a 120.4% increase). However, a decrease was observed among Day section offerings (-816 sections, a 25.4% decrease) and Evening section offerings (-352 sections, a 36.1% decrease).

Number of Sections Offered by Meeting Time: Crafton Hills College





On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 52.6% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day has declined by 15.1% from 64.2% in 2019-20 to 49.1% in 2023-24. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 21.7%, from 19.9% in 2019-20 to 41.6% in 2023-24.

An increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+339 sections, a 100.0% increase). However, a decrease was observed among Day section offerings (-292 sections, a 26.7% decrease) and Evening section offerings (-121 sections, a 44.6% decrease).

On average, between 2019-20 and 2023-24, 36.8% of total section offerings were offered during the day (between 8:00 and 4:29 p.m.). The percentage of sections offered in the Day declined by 17.3% from 59.1% in 2019-20 to 41.8% in 2023-24. Over the same period, the percentage of Unknown sections (offered via arranged hour) has increased by 24.6%, from 21.2% in 2019-20 to 45.8% in 2023-24.

Over the period, an increase in the number of sections was observed among Unknown section offerings (+988 sections, a 129.5% increase). However, a decrease was observed among Evening section offerings (-231 sections, a 32.8% decrease) and Day section offerings (-524 sections, a 24.7% decrease).
