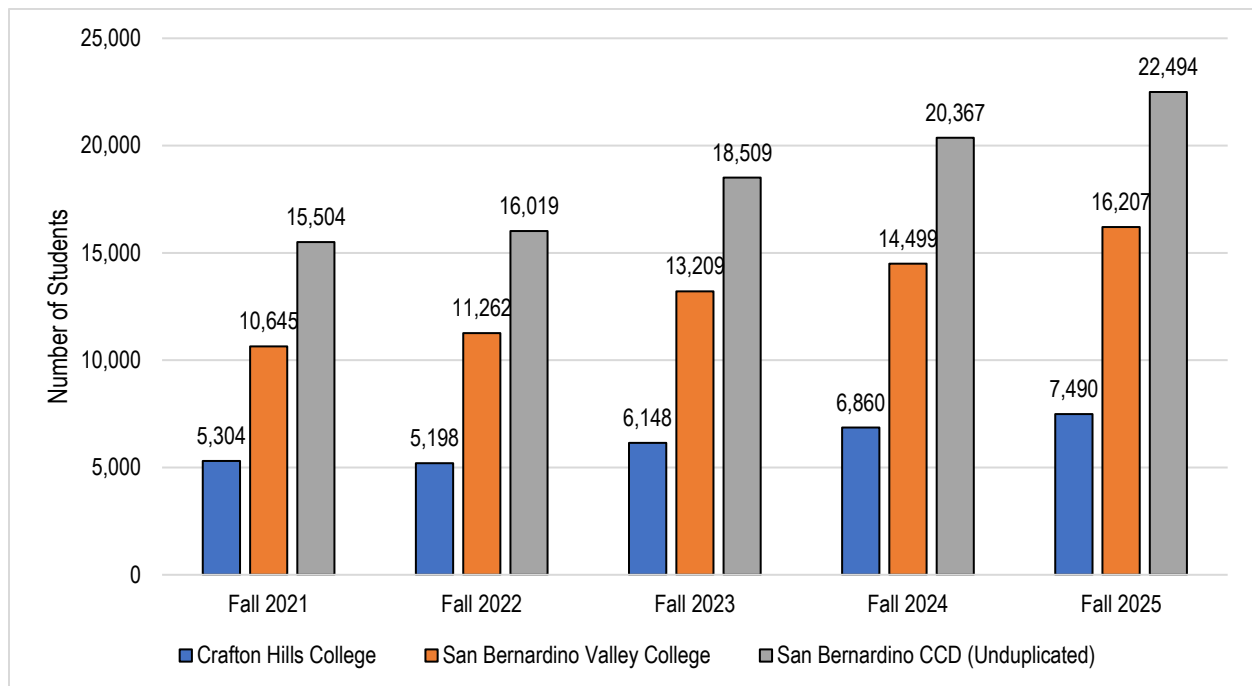

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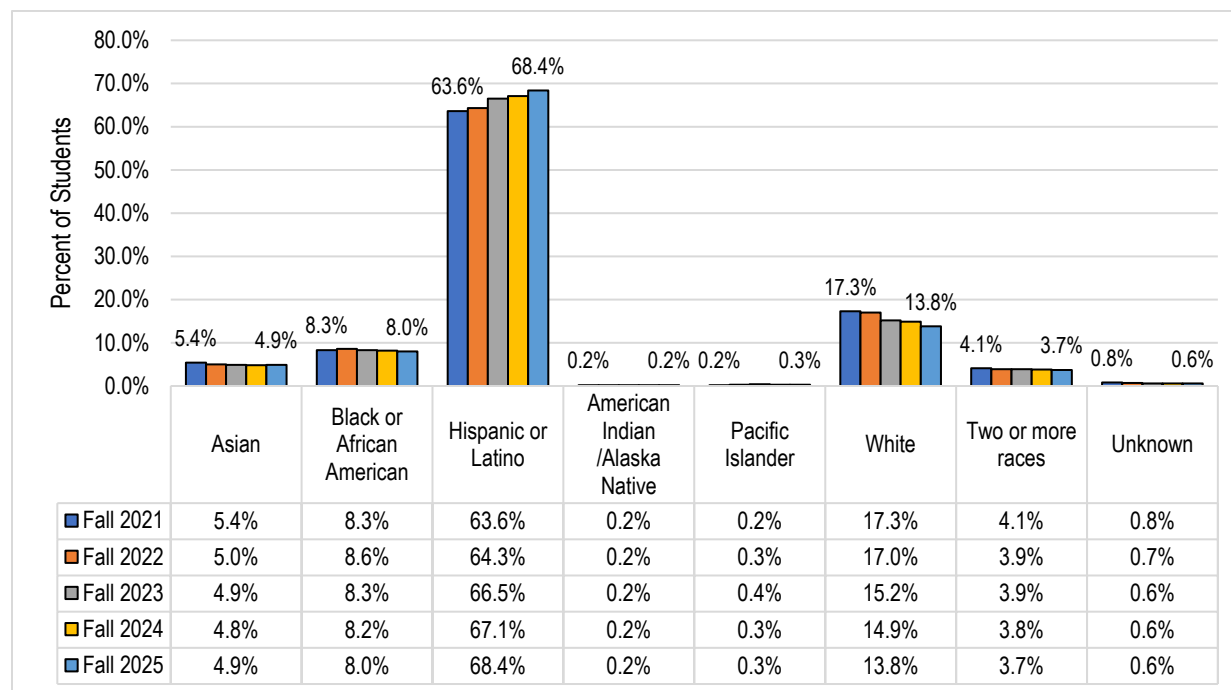

The San Bernardino Community College District student population increased by 45.1%, from 15,504 in Fall 2021 to 22,494 in Fall 2025, with a five-year average of 18,579. Overall, San Bernardino Valley College represented 68.0% of the student population, and Crafton Hills College represented 32.0% of the student population. An increase in the number of students was observed at Crafton Hills College (+41.2%) and San Bernardino Valley College (+52.2%).

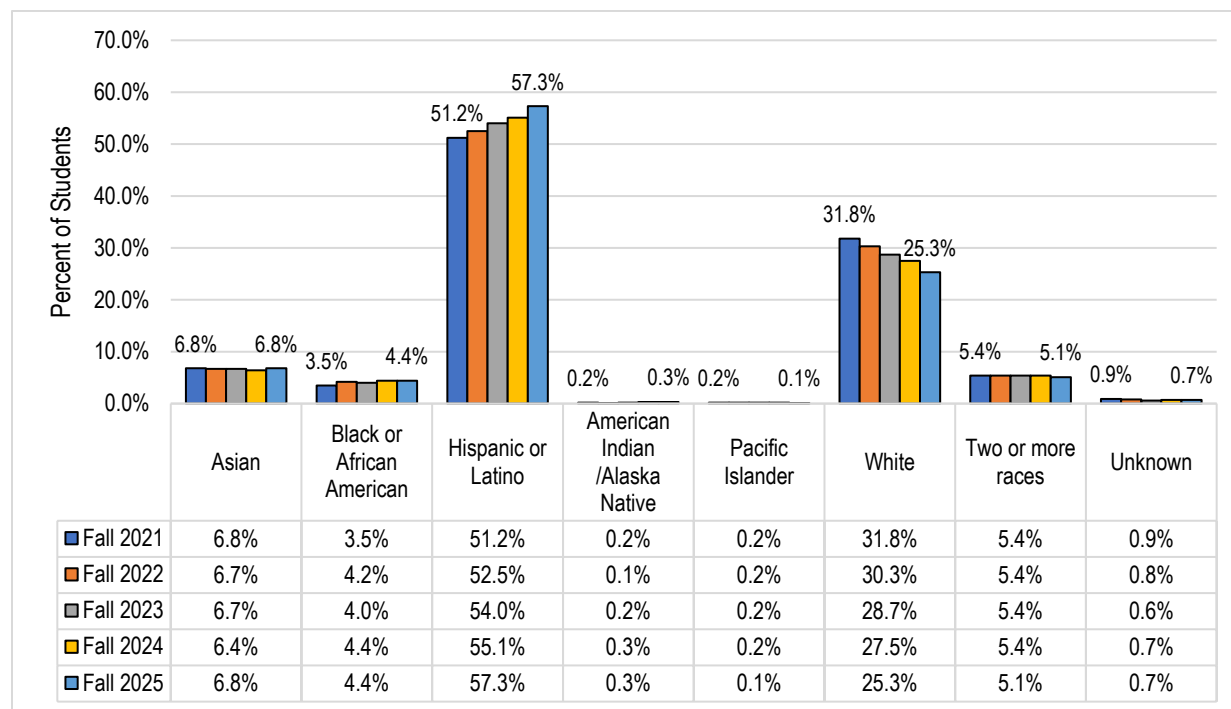

Between Fall 2021 and Fall 2025, an increase in the number of students was observed among Hispanic (+5,526), Black or African American (+524), White (+425), Asian (+265), Two or more race (+203), Pacific Islander (+29), and American Indian /Alaska Native (+16) students.

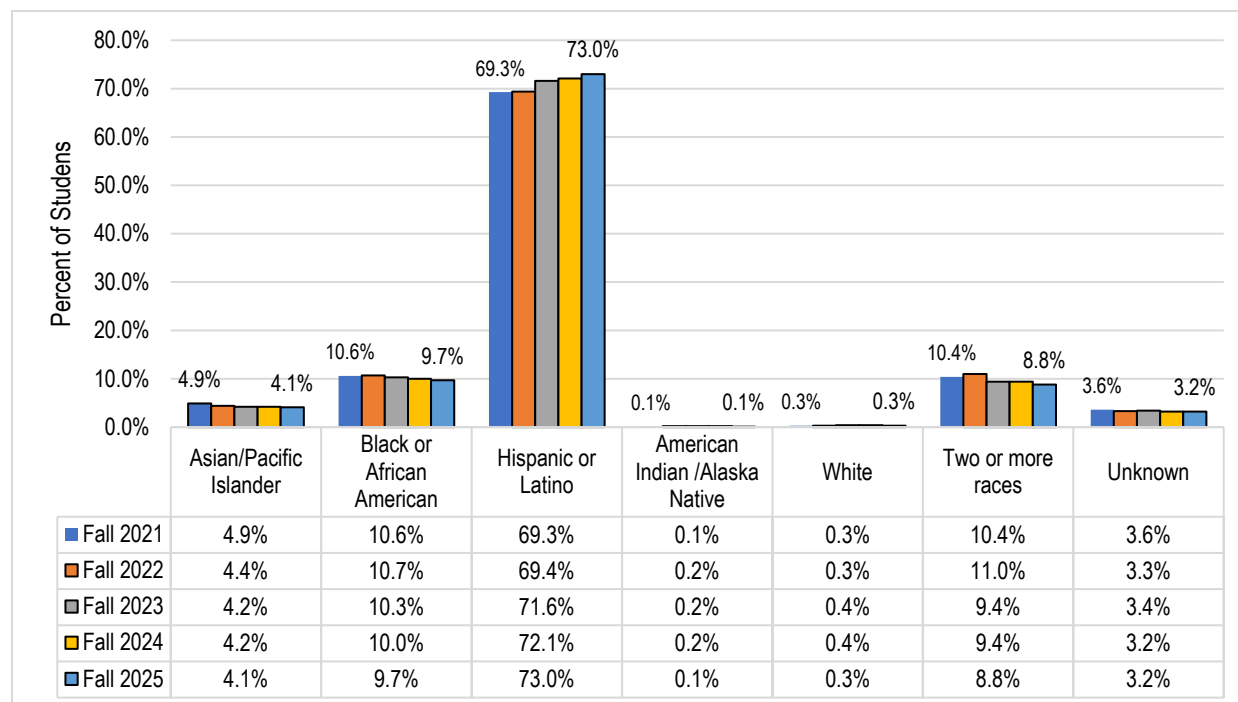

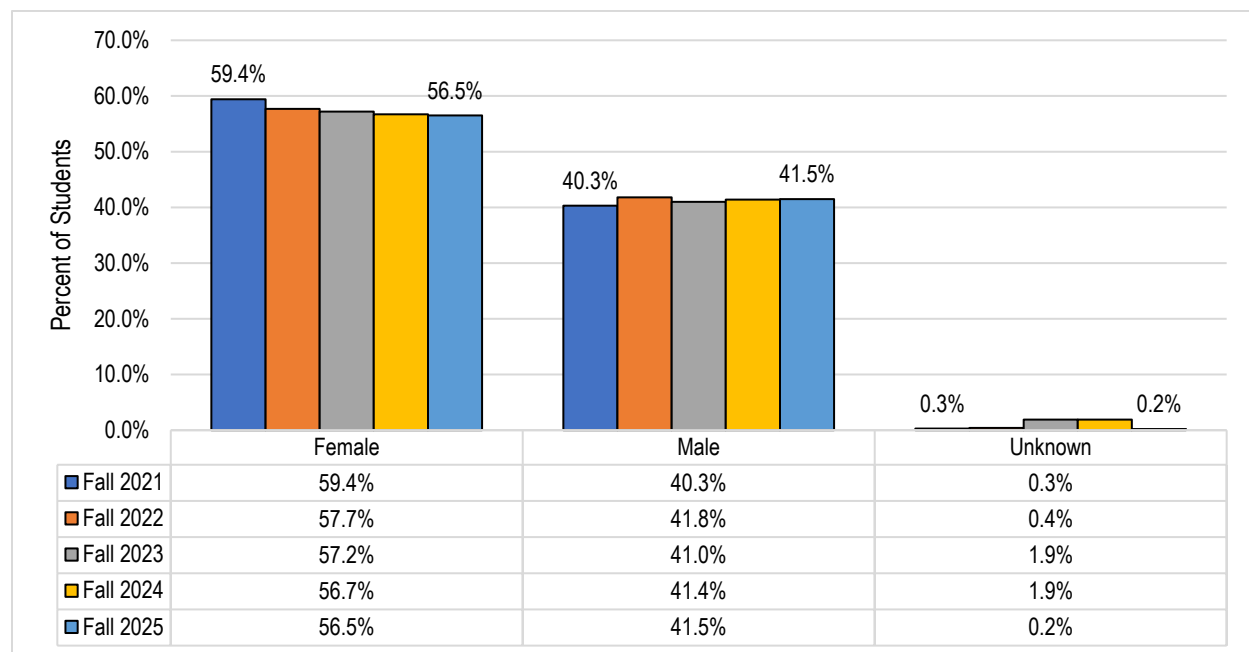

Between Fall 2021 and Fall 2025, an increase in the number of students was observed among Hispanic (+4,464), Black or African American (+445), White (+325), Asian (+144), Two or more race (+137), Pacific Islander (+24), and American Indian /Alaska Native (+8) students.

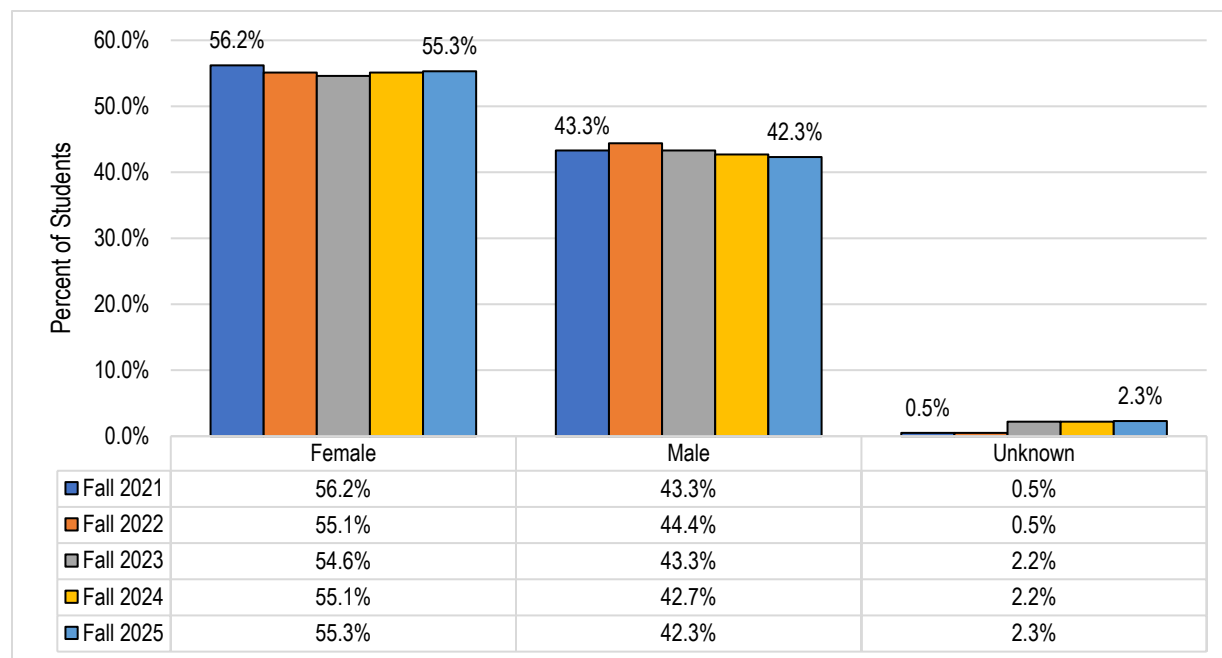

Between Fall 2021 and Fall 2025, the percentage of female students decreased by 2.9% from 59.4% to 56.5%, while the percentage of male students increased by 1.2% from 40.3% to 41.5%.

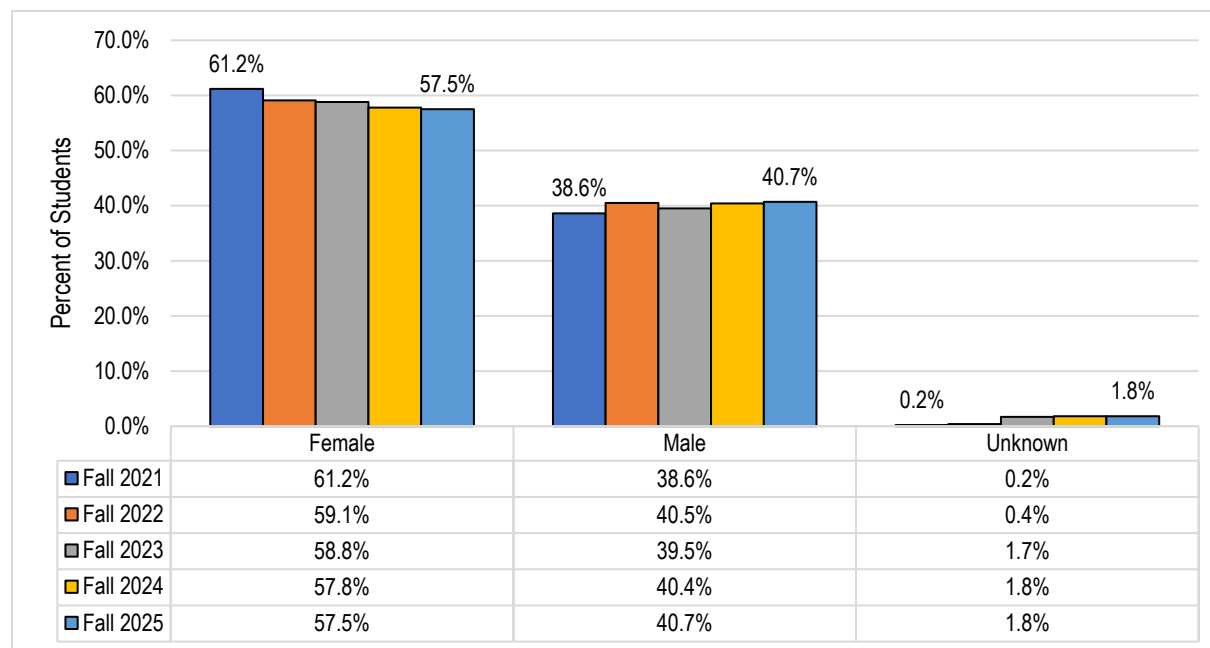

Between Fall 2021 and Fall 2025, the percentage of female students at Crafton Hills College decreased by 0.9% from 56.2% to 55.3%, and the percentage of male students also slightly declined by 1.0% from 43.3% to 42.3%. Over the same period, the percentage of students with an unknown gender increased by 1.8%.

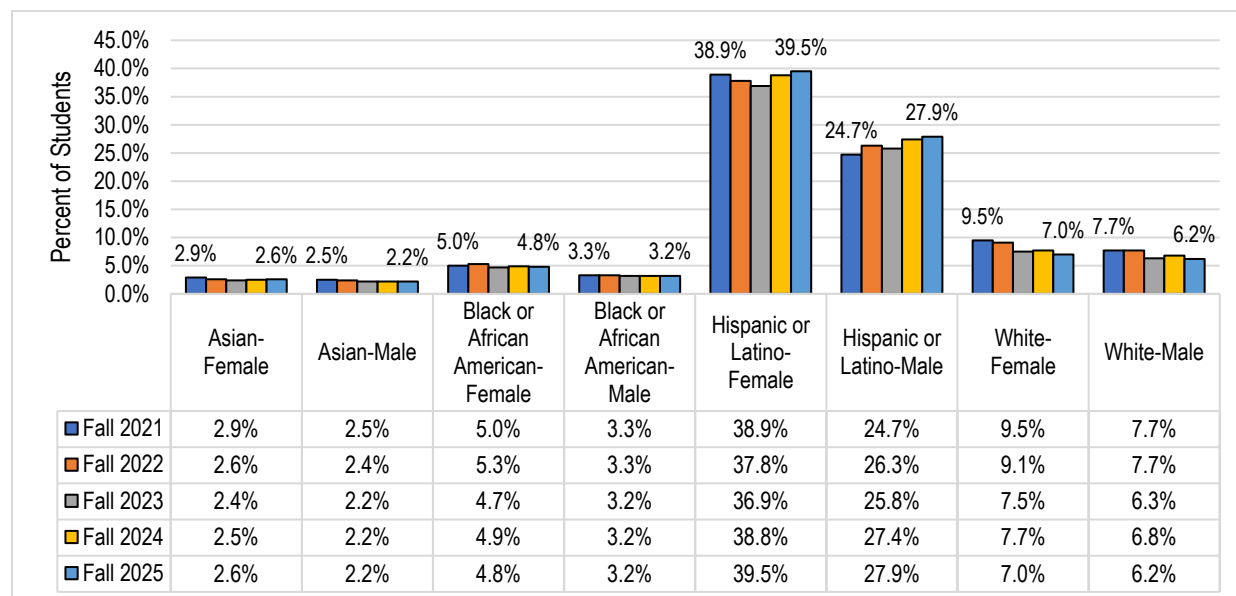

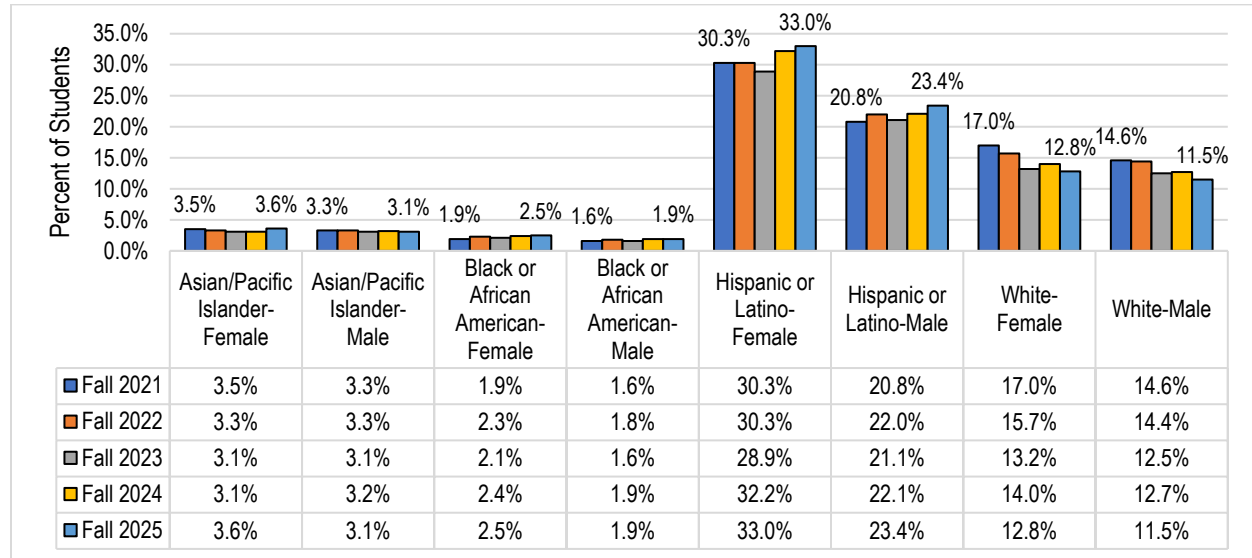

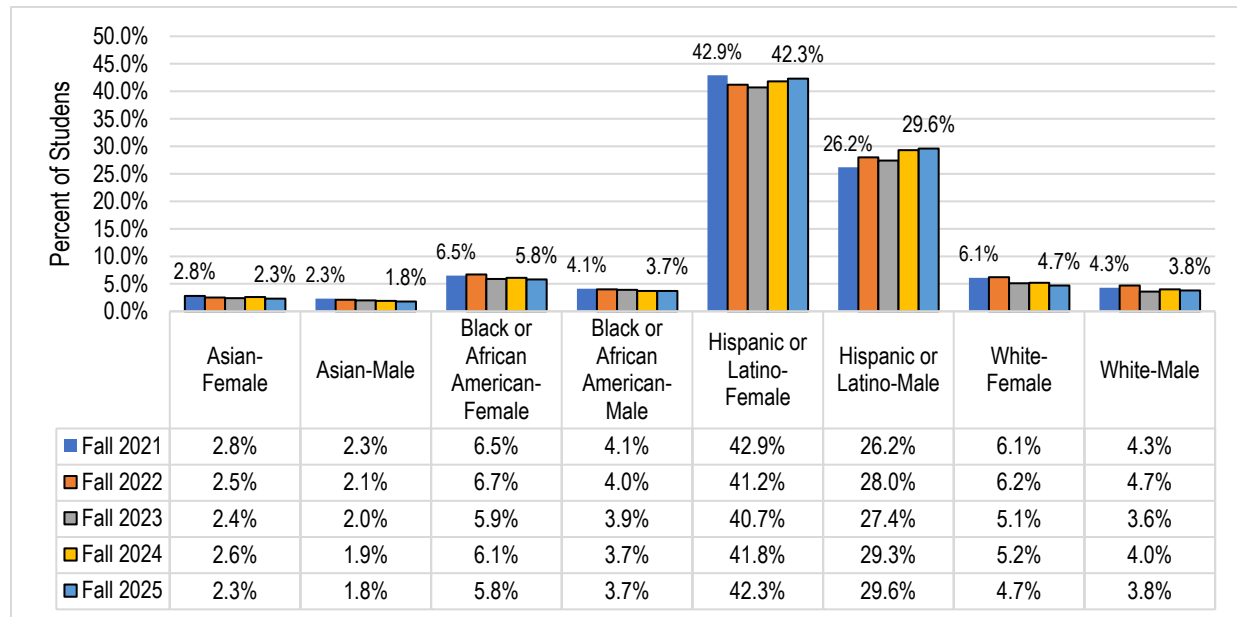

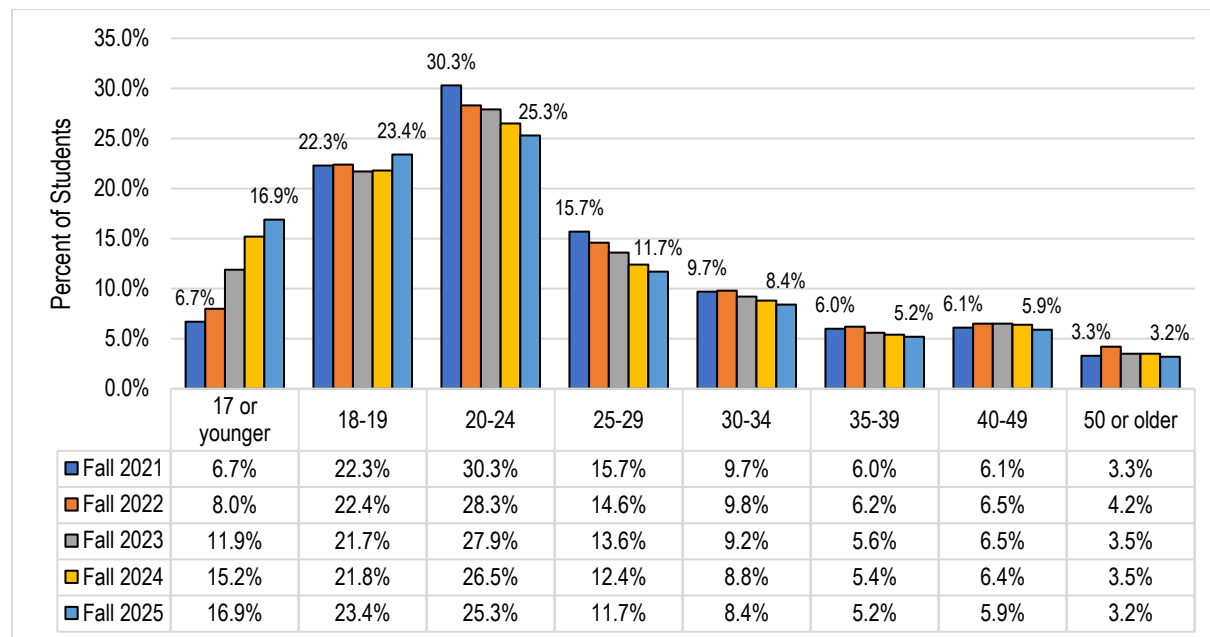

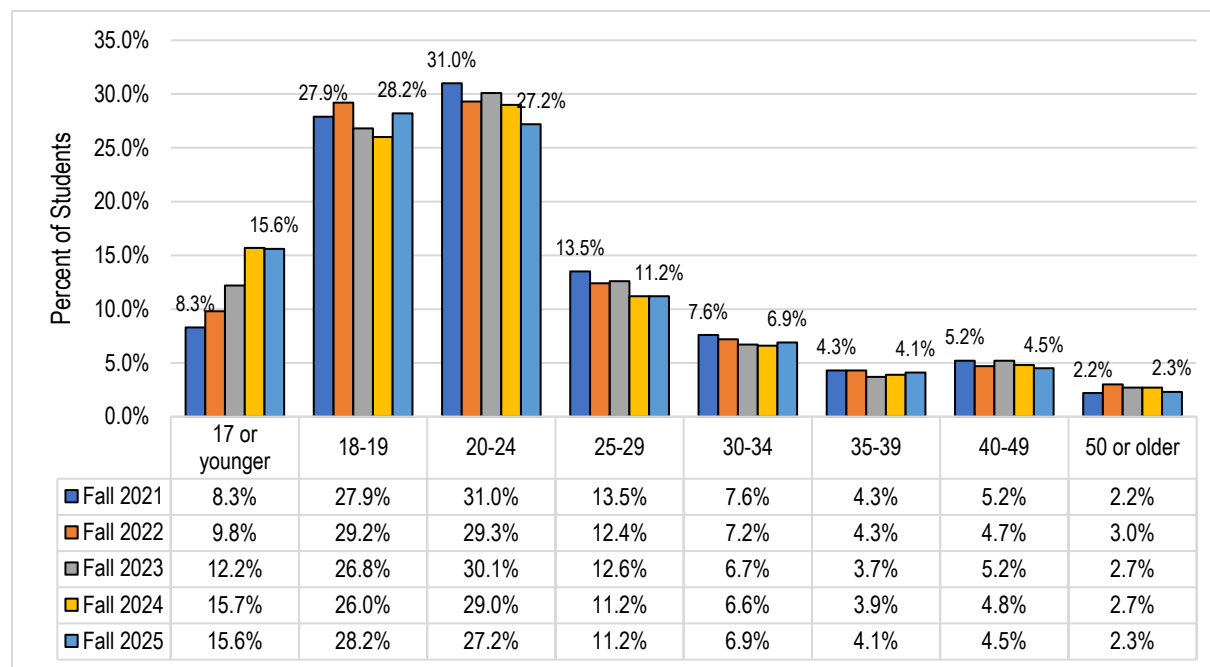

Between Fall 2021 and Fall 2025, the student body demographics saw a notable shift toward younger students. The percentage of students under 17 rose substantially by 10.2% from 6.7% to 16.9%. Over the same period, the percentages of students aged 20-24 and 25-29 declined by 5.0% and 4.0%, respectively.

The greatest increase in the number of students was observed among the under-17 age group (+2,766). The other groups saw growth in students aged 18-19 (+1,806), 20-24 (+999), 30-34 (+400), 40-49 (+376), 35-39 (+246), Over 50 (+200), and 25-29 (+197).

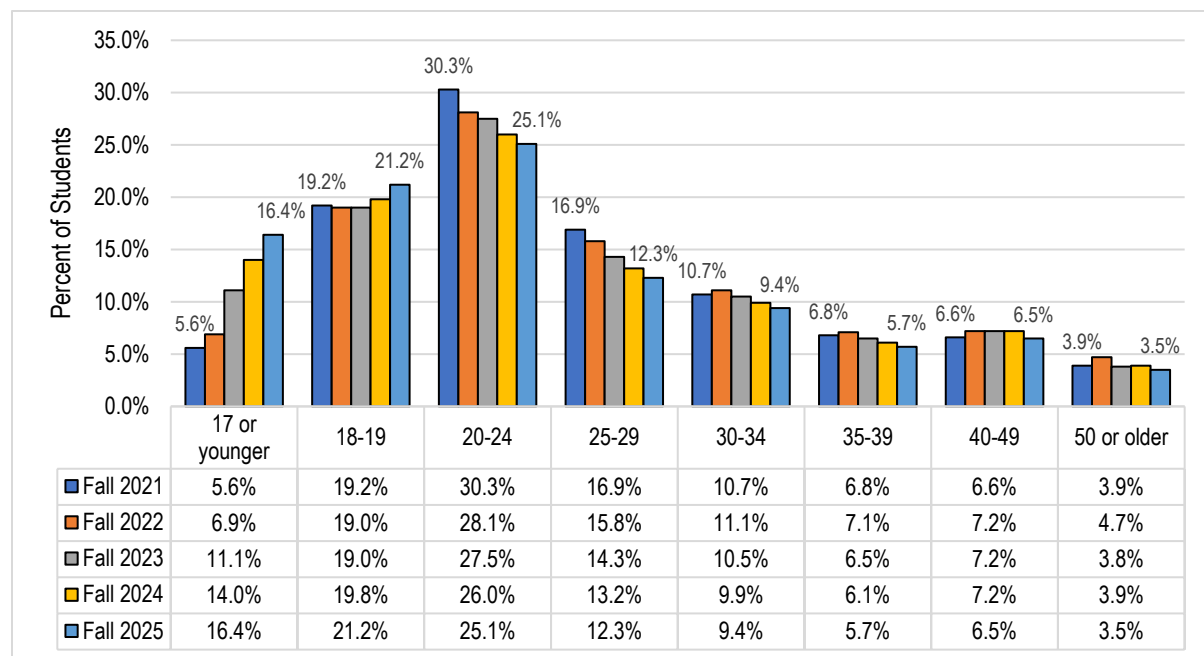

The greatest increase in the number of students was observed among the under-17 age group (+724). The other groups saw growth in students aged 18-19 (+630), 20-24 (+392), 25-29 (+123), 30-34 (+115), 35-39 (+82), 40-49 (+65), and Over 50(+55).

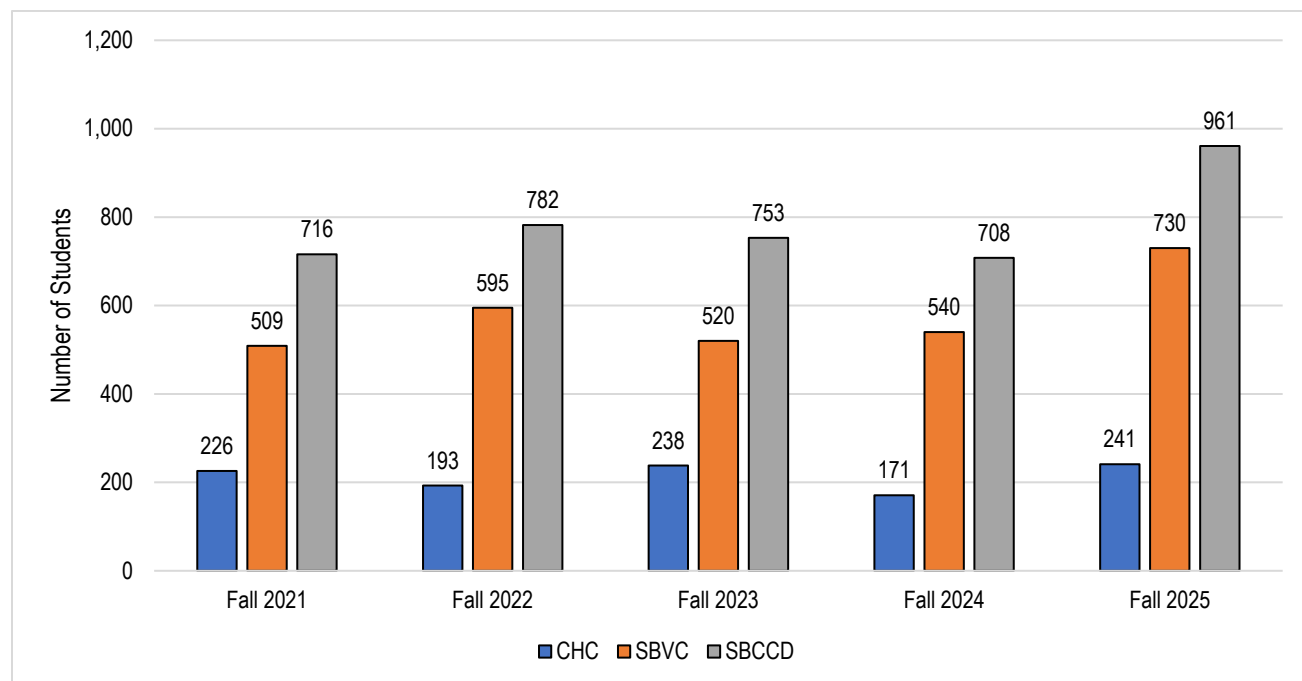

Between Fall 2021 and Fall 2025, the percentage of students under 17 rose substantially by 10.8% from 5.6% to 16.4%. The percentage of students 18-19 also increased by 2.0% from 19.2% to 21.2%. Over the same period, the percentages of students aged 20-24 and 25-29 declined by 5.2% and 4.6%, respectively.

The greatest increase in the number of students was observed among the under-17 age group (+2,060). The other groups saw growth in students aged 18-19 (+1,395), 20-24 (+844), 30-34 (+378), 40-49 (+345), 35-39(+199), 25-29(+191), and Over-50 (+150).

Student Headcount By Disability Status

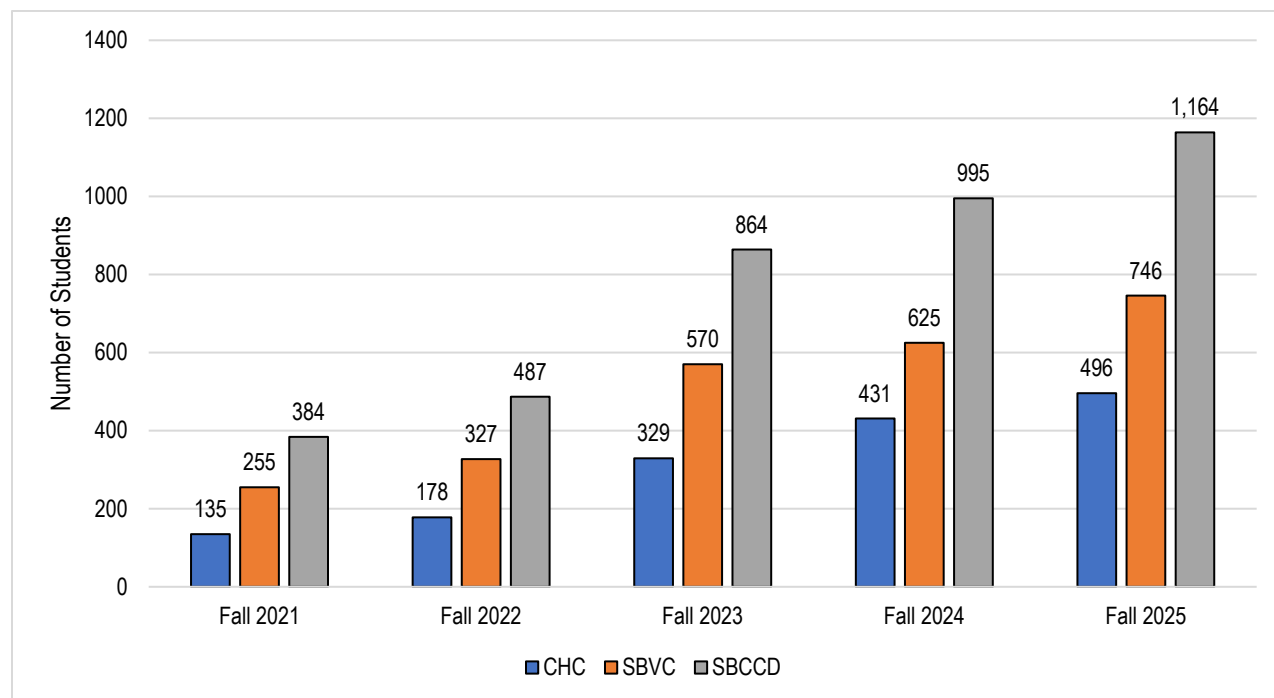

Student Headcount By Veteran Status

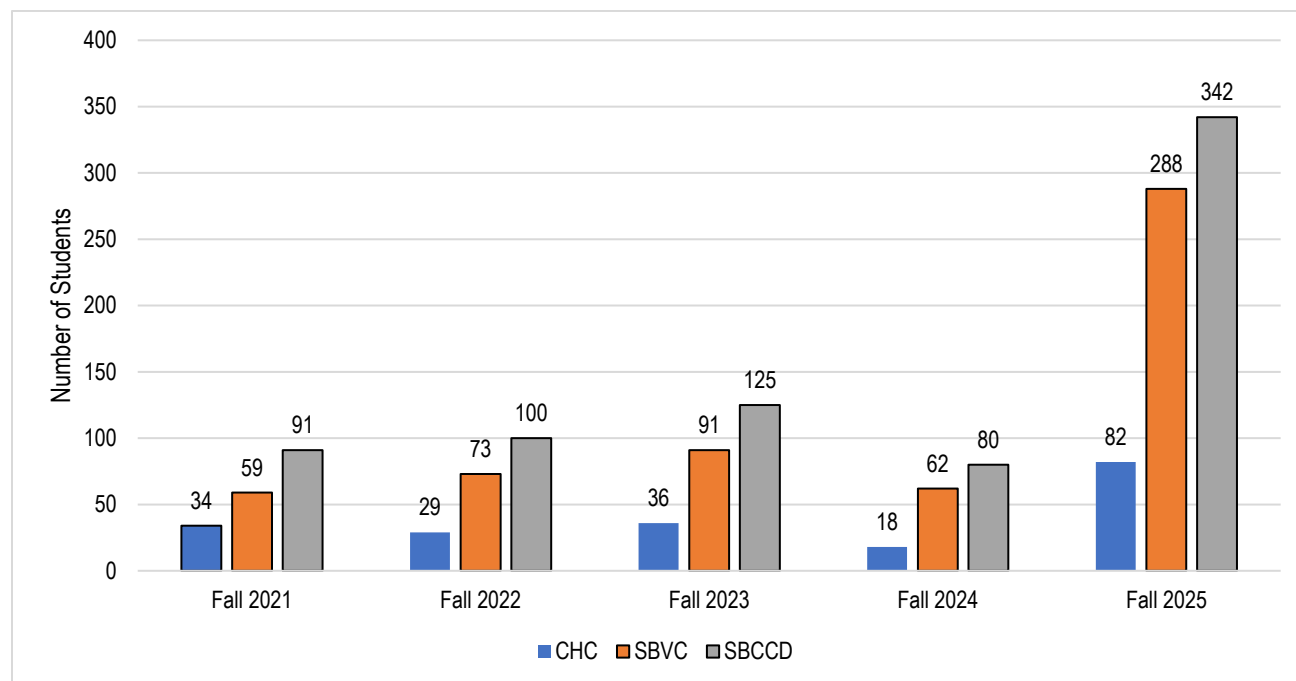

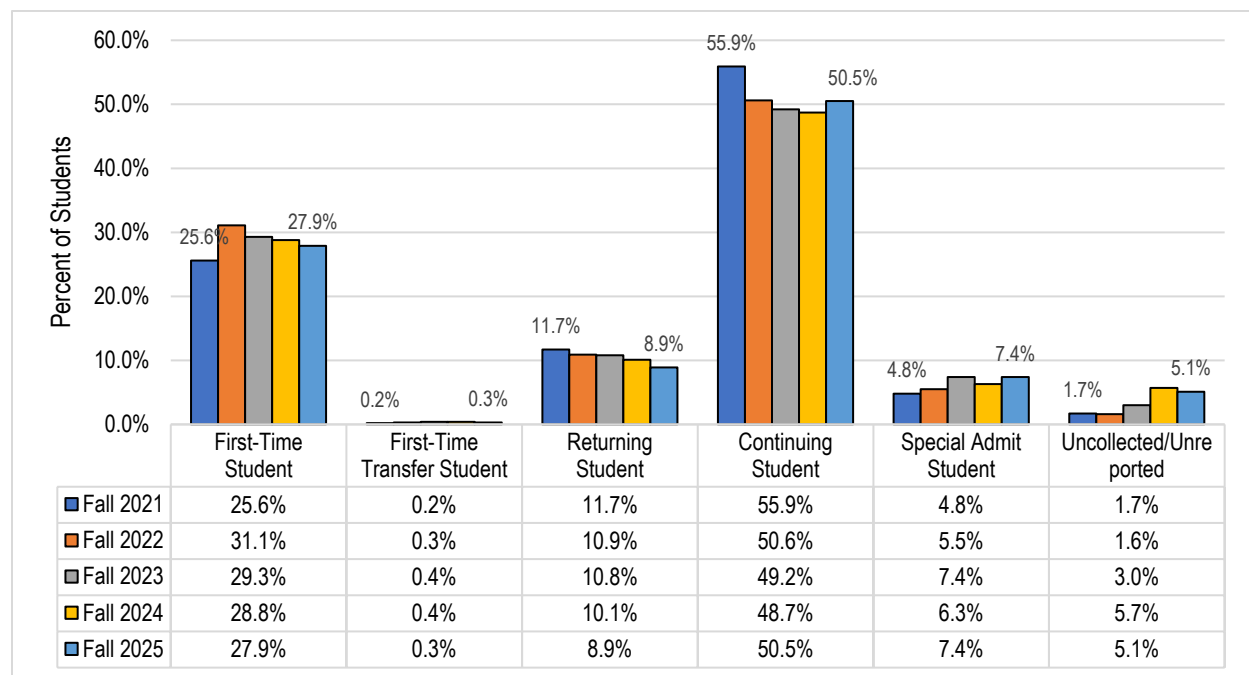
Student Headcount By Foster Youth Status

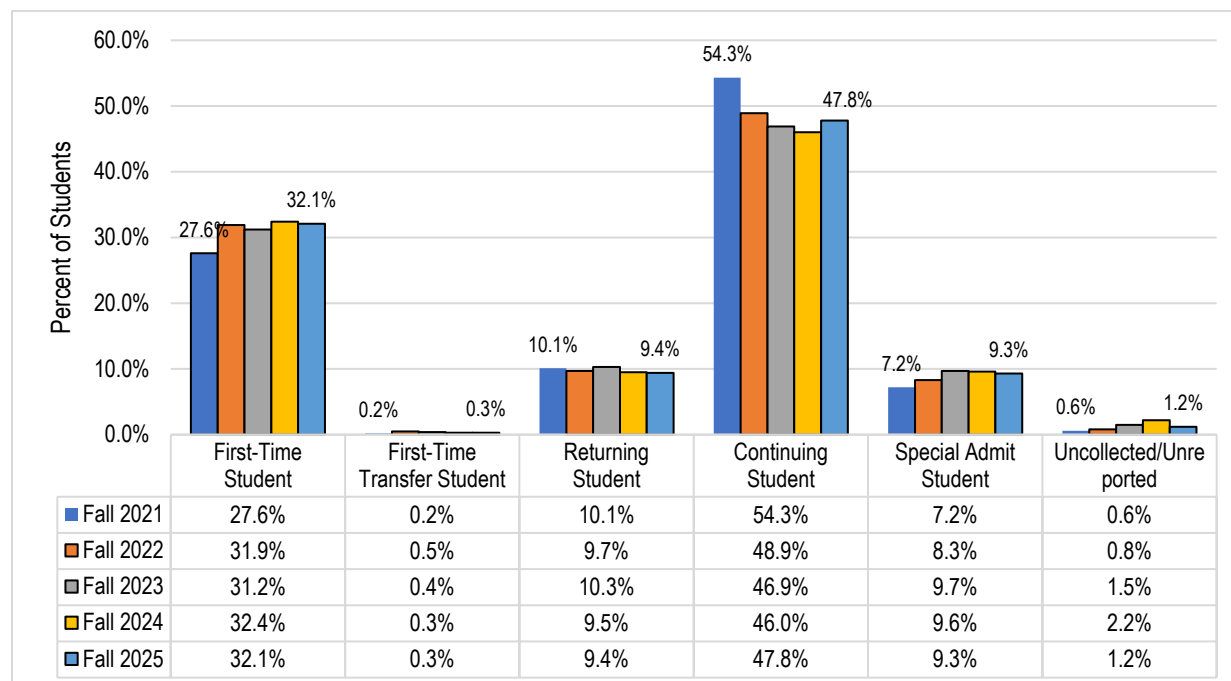

Student Headcount By Enrollment Status: Crafton Hills College



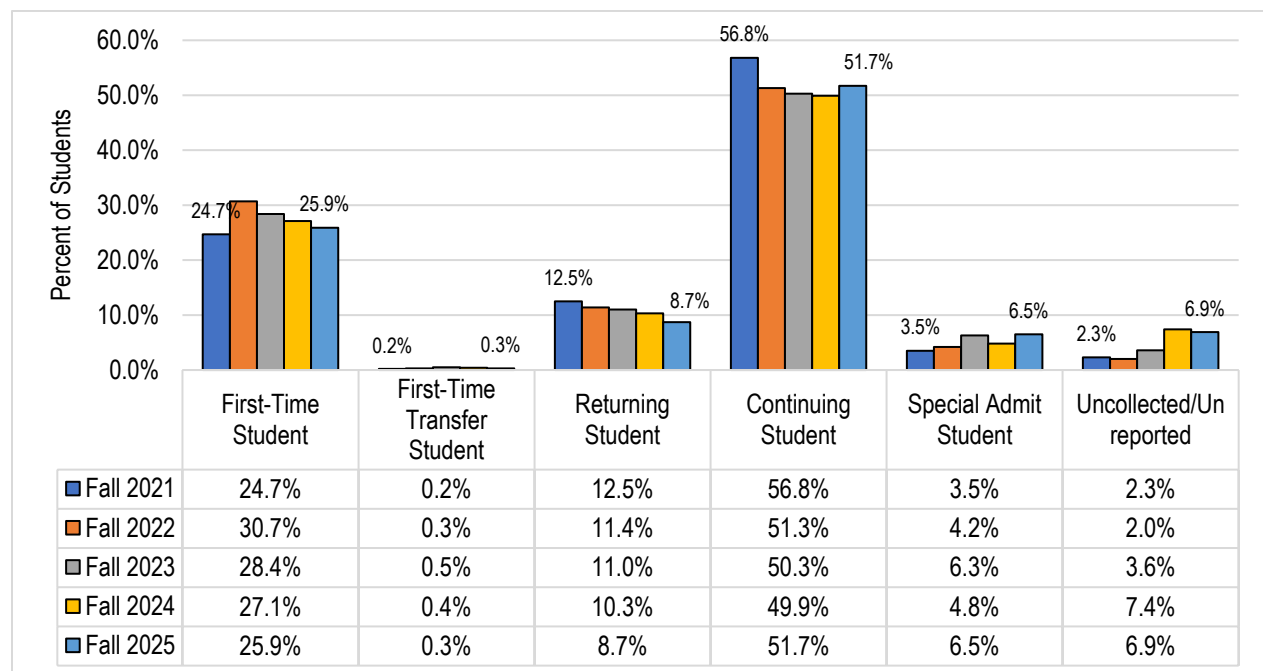

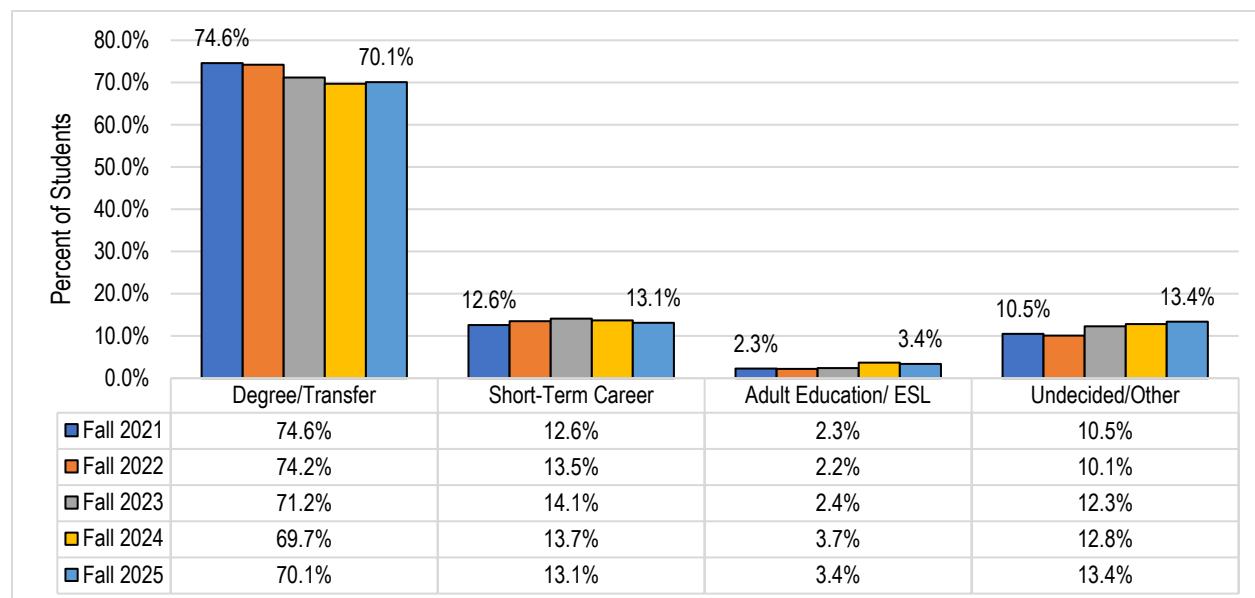

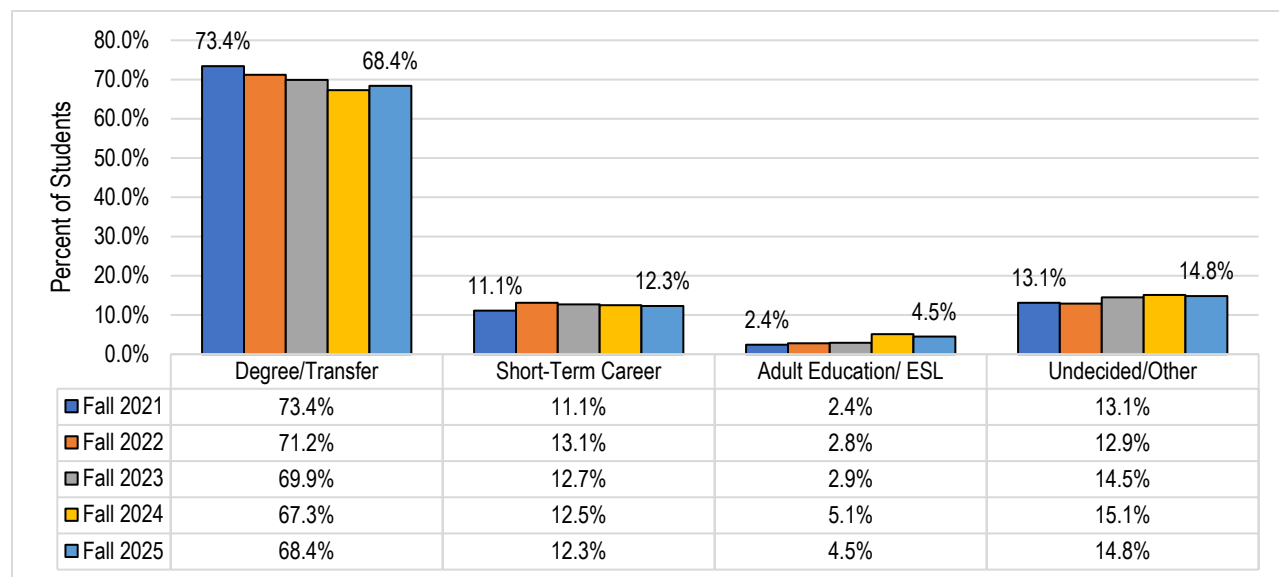
