1. Reach out to Professional Development Committees on each campus to help inform and promote incorporation into programs.

2. Development of campus sustainability committees – Ad Hoc committees might be better option due to work load and more active involvement on campuses, developed language for Ad Hoc committee charge; “To advance and implement the strategies and 7 goals of the SBCCD Sustainability Plan on this Campus, specifically - development, design, and implementation of campus policies and procedures for sustainability” Ad Hoc Committee membership may include any interested faculty, classified staff, students, and managers.

3. Contact campus VPI’s and academic senate for additional support and input.

Presidents Sustainability Commitment – Data to be provided by February, 2014. The development of the goal of becoming “Carbon Neutral” for SBCCD (includes campuses). Future action needed to define timeline for carbon neutral goal. Develop a plan of carbon reductions (3% per year????)
