 Pool or qualified bidders managed by the District
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 Podential bidders managed project and submit a Qualification
 Requirements
 Contractor license, insurance workers comp, registration
 with Proportion of Informatic Analysis, bonding capacity
 of eligibility to be awarded a public contract.

AP 6330 - Purchasing

- Encourages the use of local and small business enterprises in its procurement activities
- Ten percent (10%) preference for local vendors
- Excludes:
 - Local vendor contracts excluded by law
 - Piggy-back purchases
 - Public works construction projects

BP 6610 - Local, Minority, Women and Veteran Owned Enterprise Program

Goals:

- 50% of Local Hires
- 25% Local Businesses
- 25% Minority and Women Owned Certified Businesses
- 10% Veteran Owned Certified Businesses









Crafton Hills




Districtwide Demographics




Valley College Local vs Non-Local

Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Procedures (UCCAP)

- Informal bidding process for award of construction contracts valued at \$175,000 or less
- Pool of qualified bidders managed by the District
- Potential bidders must complete and submit a Qualification Application
- Requirements:
 - Contractor license, insurance, workers comp, registration with Department of Industrial Relations, bonding capacity & eligibility to be awarded a public contract

Contractors Bonding & Technical Assistance Program

- Approved by Board of Trustees in April 2014
- Managed by Merriwether & Williams
- Outcomes
 - 105 local contractors database
 - 15 local contractors enrolled in program
 - 7 local contractors bonded
 - Development and administration of SBCCD Contractor Training Academy

SBCCD Contractor Training Academy

- Local contractors gained better understanding of Public Works
- 10 weeks program
- 25 enrolled
 - 10 certificates of completion
 - 15 certificates of participation (attended certain courses)



Pre-Qualifications Program

Program Summary

- Pre-qualification program(s) will be implemented by the District pursuant to the authority provided for in Public Contract Code
- Program(s) are for all construction projects built by the District regardless of the funding source
- Program(s) apply to all construction delivery methods (e.g., low bid; design-build; lease lease-back, etc.)

Program Goals

Reach out to and establish well-qualified pools of contractors and subcontractors 2) Permit enrollment in such pre-qualified pools on a regular/ongoing basis 3) Develop and implement pre-qualification processes and procedures which are designed to be inclusive of residents, local businesses and local contractors
