
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SBCCD Survey 2023 - Looking Back and Moving Forward



On June 26 and 27, 2023, a 2-Day Board Retreat was held with the Board of Trustees and the SBCCD Leadership Team. As a part of the retreat, all seven members of the Board completed a self-evaluation for the 2022-2023 school year using a self-assessment instrument developed by the San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools (SBCSS) Districts' Governance Advisor Team.

The self-evaluation instrument consisted of seven categories of governance responsibilities with a total of 40 governance indicators. Evaluation forms were completed anonymously and were submitted directly to the advisors for review.



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Of the 40 Questions asked in the Self-Evaluation Survey:

10 questions had a
6-1 split
But all answers were within
one ranking of each other



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Of the 40 Questions asked in the Self-Evaluation Survey:



75% of all responses were unanimous or nearly unanimous, and were marked "Most /or All of the Time"



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Of the 40 Questions asked in the Self-Evaluation Survey:



The remaining 10 questions were split
5-2 or 4-3
But answers were heavily focused on "Most / or All of the Time"








