## Charge

## **Existing Charge**

The SBCCD Board of Trustees Budget Committee exists as a standing, advisory committee comprised of less than a quorum of Board members and is subject to the California Public Meetings Brown Act. The committee is charged with:

- Increasing the efficiency of the Board of Trustees by performing time-consuming research on its behalf
- Improving clarity by providing a platform for detailed questions not conducive to the flow of monthly business meetings.
- Promoting transparency of the SBCCD budgeting process and fiscal matters through detailed discussion of these topics in an open forum.
- Fostering an environment of understanding by communicating findings and formulating final recommendations to the Board of Trustees.

## **Proposed Charge**

An election was also held in the District on November 6, 2018 for the issuance and sale of up to \$470,000,000 of general obligation bonds of the District (the "Measure CC"). Measure CC passed with a 63.18% support (109,569 Yes votes). For this reason, BBC would like to amend its existing charge as follows:
