Executive Director Farrah Farzaneh and Associate Director Abel Favela presented a combined update of the Bond Workforce Report and Semi-Annual Bond Construction update. Highlights included local workers receiving almost \$15 million, minority, women, and veteran business have received \$17.2 million in contracts, three projects at Crafton Hills College will be completed in 2025 and 3 projects will be starting construction.

- B. Enrollment & Disaggregated Student Headcount

Vice Chancellor Ornelas was excited to update the committee on growth of the unduplicated headcount. The groups with the most significant growth were the Male group and age 17 or less. The increase can be attributed to partnerships and community outreach. Additional efforts, staffing, marketing, access to counselors and new technology also contribute to the increase in enrollment.

Executive Vice Chancellor Torres introduced Rachel Sanders and Angela Tang, PARS partners, to give an update to the committee on the pension rate. The recommendation received was to remain conservative and consistent.
