#### **Measure M Projects**

George Johnson reviewed the Measure M projects. He distributed information on the SBVC Gym which was just finishing construction. Demo of the old gyms has commenced. There has been a request for mediation from the general contractor on this project, Swinerton Builders. Just today SBCCD received notice that Swinerton wants to move toward mediation. Kitchell will be working with SBCCD legal counsel this month. At Crafton Hills, the LADM and SSA renovation projects are well underway.

#### **Review Board Items & Site Visits**

There were no comments on board items. There was some discussion about the recent visit to the SBVC Gym by Frank and Ken. It is a very impressive structure. The Gym has been designed to be LEED Silver and commissioning is now underway in pursuit of that designation. CBOC members were invited to ribbon cutting on August 26. It was mentioned that the Facilities and Educational Master Plan process was still underway.
