SBVC Technical Building Update

Project Vision: A catalyst in the Inland Empire, this state-of-the-art facility will be a focal point-of-destination that will support the changing needs of our community, industry, evolving technology and future jobs; preparing students for jobs now and jobs of the future.

Project Budget: \$107M

Schedule:

- 50% Working Drawing Design Q2 (April – June), 2020
- Submission to District State Architect
 Q3 (July September), 2020
- Start of Construction
 Q3 (July September), 2021
- Project Completion
 Q3 (July September), 2023



Refinancing of Bonds

- Measure P and Measure M
- June 2020
 - Bonds with 4.51% interest rate
 - Refinanced at 1.72%
 - Do not extend repayment term
- Lower Property Taxes by \$19.6 million*
- Credit rating upgrade 'Aa1' from 'Aa2'**
- AA Credit Rating***
- Among highest scores available in Community College District
