SBCCD Reopening Plan Update	<p>Vaccine mandate for employees is by Jan 7, 2022 with limited exemptions. The College is programming and planning on managing student vaccine mandates.</p> <p>August was the last update (version) of the reopening plan and conversations are ongoing.</p> <p>Alder: We have concerns with faculty resigning from Fire Tech. and consideration for student vaccines. Per Mike, the Board stated that no one would lose their job due to vaccine exceptions. The district is still working on implementation.</p>	District groups are working on programming for student group.

ADA update project will begin the first of the year. Vehicle enforcement for weapons on campus need to be reposted. Larry is taking care of this.</p>	Parking lot G sign (Do not enter) needs to be replaced.

CHC to be tentatively scheduled for CV vaccines on November 10, SBCCD to provide more information. Signage replacements within ADA Improvement Projects, many faded signs noted across campus. The Great Shake Out is on 10-21-21 @ 10:21am.</p> <p>Jackson: There were reported issues from members from CHC about a scam calling to solicit cash from staff. Bonnet stated that it is a Spoofing scam that seemed legit. Reach out to the police if you get a call.</p> <p>Michael N. Speaking to the mandate, reminder that there is a federal mandate. Cal Osha will have 30 days to implement. We will be mindful of exemptions, more information to come.</p>

No injuries for CHC for the month of September.</p> <p>Walker: Vaccine event-- Working on removing barriers for staff to meet the expectation by making the vaccine accessible, possibly on campus on October 19th. Looking for mobile vaccines or testing on campus. Still waiting for confirmation. Mid November and early December dates are being considered. Paul and Michael will be attending our upcoming safety events.</p> <p>There is an emphasis on getting a flu shot this year.</p>
