- Possible problem with CCCApply Application Importation of Institutions Attended information.
- Need to fix existing records in Datatel: 18XX years
- Current reporting for CHC is much lower than it really is.
- Recent MIS submissions have required pulling data from CCCApply to correct submission data. (Last 2 years)
 - o Needed to meet allowed error %.
- We have corrected error reports to assist in finding these students at submission.

Comments from Dianna Jones: Ellucian (Datatel) has programmatically resolved the SB11/SB15 discrepancy problem.

Here is the logic flow of importing from CCCApply

- High school completion dates are entered into IIA.START.YEARS and IIA.END.YEARS
- High school attendance dates are entered into IIA.START.DATES and IIA.END.DATES
- Enrollment Status is translated:
 - o (1 First-time student at a U.S. college) = FFV
 - o (2 Transfer student from another U.S. college)=FTV
 - o (3 Returning to this college)=RSV
 - (1A- Enrolling in high school (or lower grades) and college at the same time)=SPV
 Note: This is no longer available in CCCApply, but we still translate it.

Here is the logic flow of SB11:

- Cycles through institution attend records looking for award degrees of from CAST.SB11 table (none).
- If non found, then Cycles through institution attend records looking for grad types from SB.EDUC.STATUS
 - o If found, use INSTA.END.DATES (year)

Here is the logic flow of SB15:

- If SB11 is 100 then report "Y"
- If the student is only enrolled in Non-Credit courses report "X"

- If student is not enrolled in current reporting term report "X"
- If student was enrolled in one of the Continuing Terms report "5"
- If one of the Continuing Terms is the first term as well as a summer term report "1"
- Else if student was not enrolled in Continuing Term
- translate STA.ENROL.STATUS via CAST.SB15 table, if it's blank use STA.ADMIT.STATUS via CAST.SB15.B.

Enrollment status is only updated (via. ALES rules or manually on STAL) when an applicant becomes a student. It is not updated at any other time even if there are rules that a person would pass later. So, basically this value is set, and then never changed. In order to have this status updated automatically, customization would have to be made.
