I. Updating User App to include Starfish roles and permissions

Sponsor: Joe Cabrales and Kristina Heilgeist

- Andy added a Starfish checkbox in the user app, but the managers will have to enter the role in on the form.
- SBVC said that only certain people can request authorized access for other users to access Starfish, Andy asked CHC for the same. If a manager signs for a user, is that enough of a legitimate request?
- The only people who are authorized to give access on CHC side is Joe Cabrales and Kirsten Colvey. Whoever wants to authorize or request Starfish access, will have to go through them. If anyone else asks for access, TESS will inform the person to go through Joe or Kirsten.
- Joe will inform other managers, when they request for Starfish access to notify Joe or Kirsten.
- Make sure to put in the notes section what roles this user should have.
- Should not request through helpdesk tickets, request via user app.

II. Transcripting

- Kristina provided some information justifying the need for new CCD codes CCMPL and CCMPT.
- DyAnn pointed out that not many programs use that field. It is multi-valued.
- Corrina said that many of the courses still contains UG, any courses that's attached to the NC programs will needs to be updated. DyAnn said it may not affect the transcript.
- Corrina thinks to keep it consistent, future sections should be updated. DyAnn pointed that existing student records will still have UG.
- Corrina asked about how to exclude Pseudo courses from MIS reporting. She said nothing has been confirmed.
- An example of Pseudo courses was brought up, looking under CRSE, TRELEC-CCSU/A1. Credit Type. TRNDG
 code is coded, this is used to identify Pseudo courses.
- Corrina said she will do some testing on this regarding MIS reporting.
- DyAnn asked Kristina to submit a ticket request for this research.
- Pseudo courses should be excluded in the Academic Standing transcripts.
