II. Transcript Printing – 8/18/2008 date check

Sponsor: Joe Ho, Kristina Heilgeist

- Logic exists in the transcript printing program that says if the program end date is greater than or equal to 8/18/2008, then check for VCCP or CCPR. If either of these exists, do not print the Certificate information.
- However, a program with end date less than 8/18/2008 will print the Cert information and ignore the VCCP and CCPR code, even if these codes exist.
- Should this be updated?
- Programming notes -SBCCD project #193 - Don't print certificates less than 18 credits per Title V authority as of 12/1/08. Added variable X.PRINT.DATE.GRANTED to control printing or not printing. We check the CCDs for a code of VCCP (Valley unprintable) or CCPR (Crafton unprintable). If we find either of these codes we don't print the CERT line. The rule is, as long as any of the CCDs match an unprintable code we will not print the CERT line! I also re-designed the code into a set of CASE statements to make the meaning clearer and eliminate extra process instructions. This modification is as of 08/18/08
