I. BOG and Financial Aid rebilling

Sponsor: April Dale-Carter

- SBVC and CHC FA offices, when the students are awarded BOG, FA is doing manual rebilling.
- This has come up as a “negative” during an audit. FA should not be doing the rebilling.
- Asking for A&R to do the rebilling. But A&R don’t know when a student receives their BOG. Students are running around to get their account updated.
- Audit finding is that FA should not be doing the rebilling, Andy wants to look at the audit finding.
- Andy says that billing should not be run wide open, every time. He thinks maybe a new business process may help.
- John Muskavitch thinks that legally maybe FA should not be doing this. Larry thinks that since FA is not disbursing money, resulting in a check being cut, so he thinks just running rebilling should be ok.
- Sam Trejo joined the discussion around 00:49:33. Confirmed that they are not using Self Service for students to check their awards. Instead, they will use CampusLogic.
- Sam also confiemd that FA is doing rebilling for the past few years. The audit finding says that they should not be doing not. He is trying to get the internal audit report from Larry Strong.
- John Muskavitch said that because FA is the one awarding the waiver, they should not be the ones waiving the fees. It falls under the federal guidelines of separation of dutues. College of the Dessert for example was having FA doing the rebill, and they are now moving towards having A&R doing the rebill.
- Larry thinks that because the rebilling does not result in sending money to the student, he thinks that separation of duties may not apply here. John is thinking they should talk to the Feds regarding this.
- John contacted one of his connections at the Feds, he will reach out Joe and April.
- Andy suggest that CHC get a demo of CampusLogic.

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II. Starfish related

- There's an attribute built on early alert sides, don't know where that came from. How to connect the attribute to the flag?
- Initially the term was set out for six, but we are only getting four. Andy asked Yancie to submit a ticket.
- Plan is to stay on Colleague Ed Plans for at least a year after Valley go live, will have both systems running side-by-side. Planning to go live in Summer 2020.
- Both Colleges will be using early alert.

Many things that Self Service does was moved off to outside services through the years, because of so much externalizing of functions from Self Service, if we were to go off WebAdvisor will be a challenge.
- The cost to recustomize Self Service may be very high.
