 1. MIS Patch Updates • CB25 • CB26 • SB38 	 As we've been discussing, CB25 is the Course-General-Education-Status patch. Area A includes written communication, critical thinking and English critical thinking. Area B includes mathematics/quantitative reasoning and concepts. Area C is not transferable for GE math but fulfills local general education for Analytical Thinking or Math Competency. CB26 is Course-Support-Course-Status patch. Identifies whether a course is associated with another degree-applicable course for the purpose of providing the support necessary to complete the associated course. The initial data entry has been/will be completed by TESS. Please remember to add this to your process for any new courses from this point forward. SB38, Student-Expanded-Ethnicity, data used to report all expanded ethnicities with which a student identifies. "N" is the default. In addition to the information mentioned above, there were some other updates. Case in point, EOPS. If you see changes you are unfamiliar with, please give me a call. Thank you to the VPI Offices and Articulation Officers from both colleges for reviewing the information and adding and/or correcting the courses initially entered during the testing phase.
