4 SUSTAINABILITY

6 The District Office and the Colleges will develop a Sustainability Plan with participation by a committee  
7 comprised of representation from faculty, classified staff, students, College Presidents, and senior  
8 administrators, with input from the campus communities through public forums or other means.  
9

10 The Sustainability Plan will guide future sustainability efforts at the District and at the Colleges. The plan  
11 may be organized around the following categories:  
12

- 13 1. Green Buildings (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design)
- 14 2. Energy Conservation and Alternative Energy
- 15 3. Water Conservation
- 16 4. Waste and Recycling
- 17 5. Transportation
- 18 6. Business Practices and Policies
- 19 7. Academic Instruction and Workforce Training
- 20 8. Climate/Greenhouse Gas Emissions (Presidents' Climate Commitment)
- 21 9. Communication and Outreach
- 22 10. Funding (Internal and External Sources).

24 The Chancellor will submit the Sustainability Plan to the Board for its review and provide annual reports  
25 on the progress of sustainability efforts.
