

## POLICE/SECURITY JOB HAZARD ASSESSMENT

Job Hazard	Hazard Control
Trip or fall hazards	Walking/working surfaces training for working around uneven, wet and slippery surfaces (includes warning to others of slippery surfaces); use cord cover and out of traffic areas
Contact with bloodborne diseases such Hepatitis B, AIDS	Require vaccination for Hepa B; use univeral precautions
Periodic lifting/climbing/bending/stooping  Injuries while performing arrest	Use proper lifting techniques; Ergonomic training; use dolly/cart Use protective vests, gloves; always carry
injuries while performing arrest	handcuffs; have means of communications for back-up; train in arrest and control techniques
Contact with communicable diseases, bacterial contamination	Use universal precations; clean contaminated surfaces immediately with appropriate disinfectant
Injuries from vehicular accidents	Wear seatbelt at all times; follow traffic rules; practice defensive driving; park in authorized spaces and do not obstruct traffic; do not use radio/phone while operating vehicle
Fire and Emergency response	Training would include: fire extinguisher use, phone communication, first aid
Injuries from performing traffic control	Wear high visibility vest; use temporary barriers, warning signs; training on working with vehicle traffic, device usage and placement
