

Goal 1 – Student Success KPI 1.5 – Number of Transfers to 4-year Colleges Each Year


Objective: Increase student success while preserving access, enhancing quality, and reducing attainment gaps associated with income, race, ethnicity, age, and gender.


Definition: The number of students who transfer to a four-year institution (measured annually from summer to spring). Includes CSU, UC, in-state private, and out-of-state baccalaureate granting institutions.

Measurement Frequency: Annual

EQUITY ANALYSIS: Please note that equity data is not available for in-state private and out-of-state institutions. As a result, data presented in the graph on the right <u>only</u> reflects the number of transfers to CSUs and UCs for each race/ethnicity. Also, <u>only</u> UCs provide equity data for gender, thus the graph on the left only reflects gender differences for UC campuses.





SUMMARY OF THE DATA:

Transfers to 4-year institutions (Overall): There was a <u>net increase</u> of 364 students that transferred to a four-year college since the 2014-2015 academic year. This amounts to an <u>average increase</u> of 121 transfers each year and an <u>average</u> of 1333 transfers each year over this four-year period. There was a <u>total</u> of 5332 transfers over this four-year period.
