



 - Bids must still be submitted hard-copy, but bid openings are now occurring virtually (Zoom)




Doing Construction During a Pandemic

- PPE: Masks & Gloves Added as Mandatory
- COVID Precaution Reminders
- Max Occupancy Restrictions
 - No more than 5 Workers in a room or enclosed area at a time
 - Maintain 6 feet where possible
- Daily Briefings in Open Areas
- Project Meetings Held Remotely
- Prep in Open Areas
- Inspections Conducted in Steps




